





Graphical Representation of Smartkids Ghana Financial report












Thank You to Our **Printer Fundraising Donors** – Help Us Reach Our Goal!


In March, our total expenditure stood at \$1,028.17, which was strategically allocated across key operational areas to maximize impact.

A Deeper Look at Expenses

Salaries costs amounted to \$617.00. A total of \$617.00 was received to cover the monthly salaries of five staff members.

Operational cost: These costs cover the day-to-day operational expenses of running the organization in Ghana, office supplies, scholars birthday celebration,, and other general overheads. While program expenses take the majority of the funds, operational costs are necessary to maintain efficient operations and support the implementation of initiatives.








