## Studentambassadors recruited in February 2025




February marked an exciting milestone for SmartKids Ghana as we welcomed **eight new Student Ambassadors i**nto our growing network of young changemakers. These




In February, our total expenditure stood at \$1,294.34, which was strategically allocated across key operational areas to maximize impact.

### A Deeper Look at Expenses

**Salaries** costs amounted to \$658.00 A total of \$658.00 was received to cover the monthly salaries of five staff members.

**Operational Costs:** These costs cover the day-to-day operational expenses of running the organization in Ghana, office supplies, scholars birthday celebrations, communication tools and other general overheads. While program expenses take the majority of the funds, operational costs are necessary to maintain efficient operations and support the implementation of initiatives.


**Organizational Expenses:** This month's organizational costs covered essential operational services and compliance-related fees to ensure smooth functioning and maintain administrative requirements.


