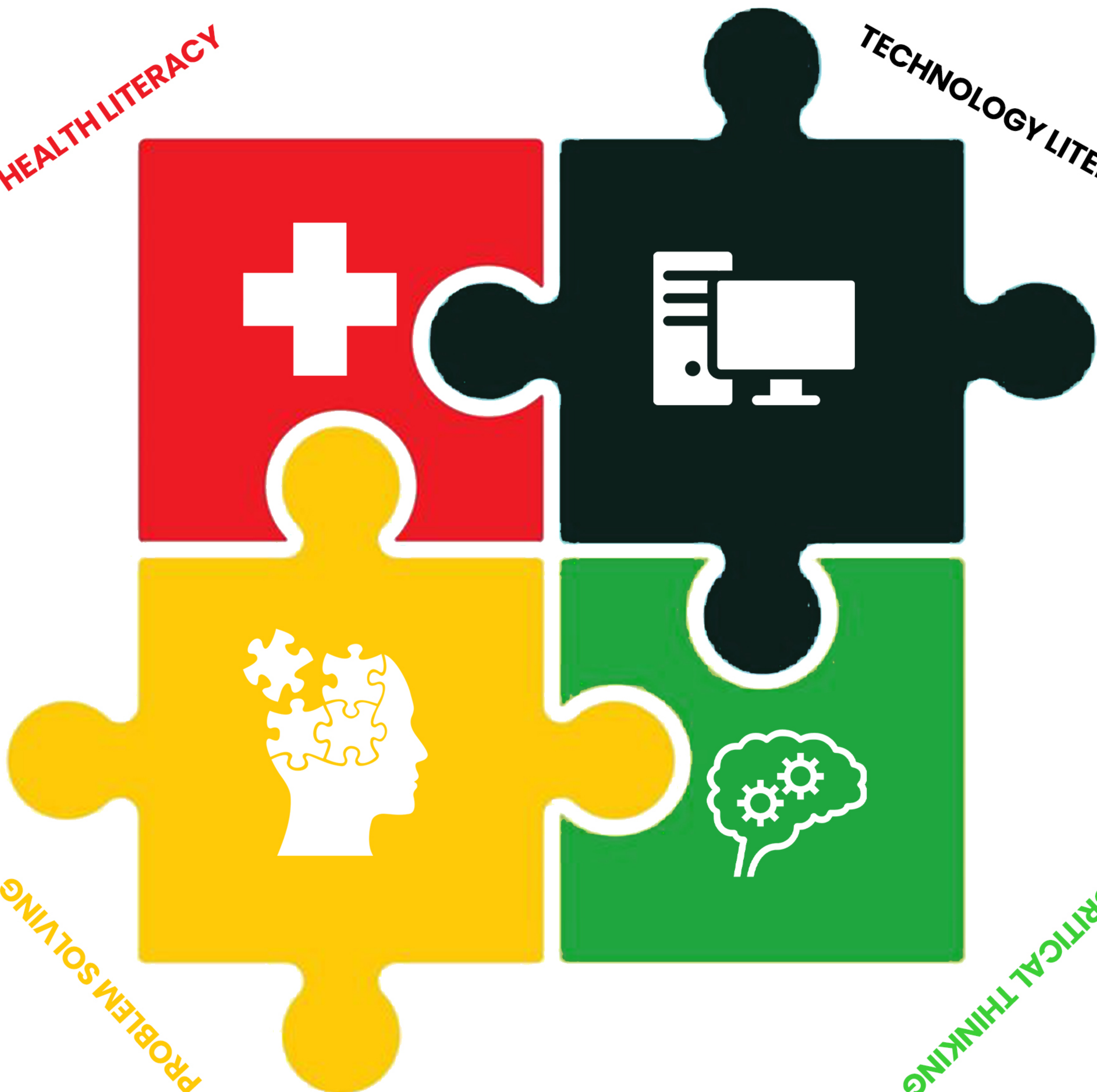

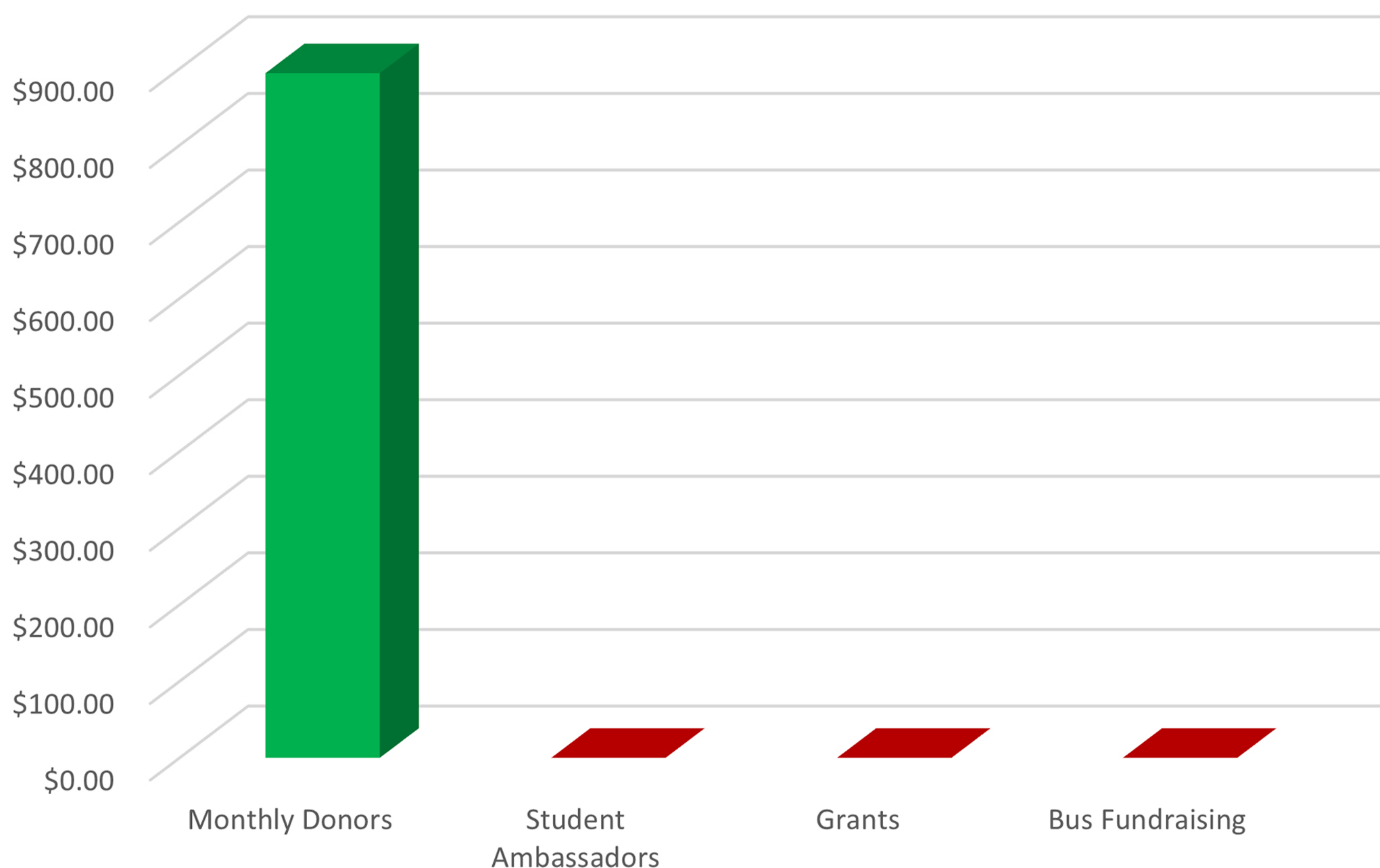

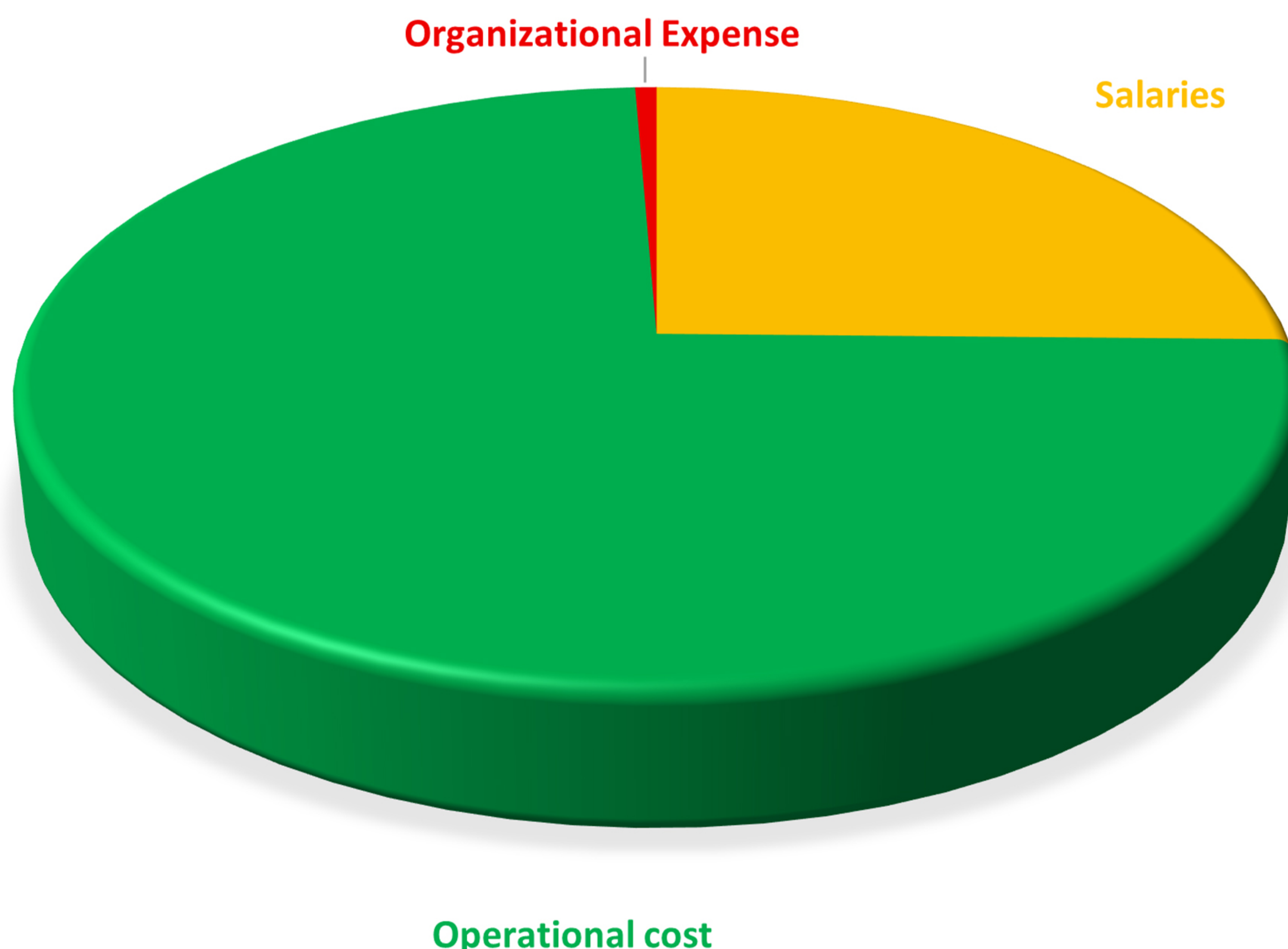
In January, our total expenditure stood at \$2,336.00, which was strategically allocated across key operational areas to maximize impact.

A Deeper Look at Expenses

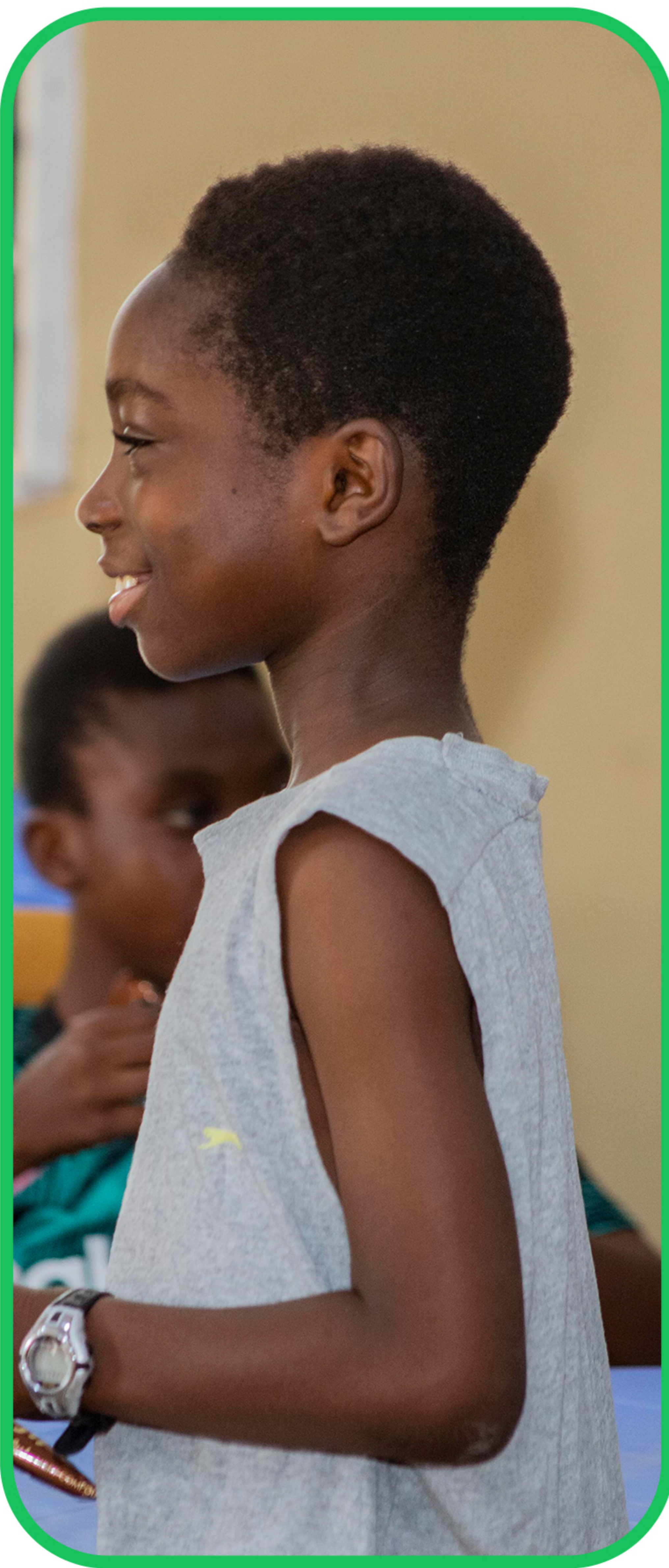
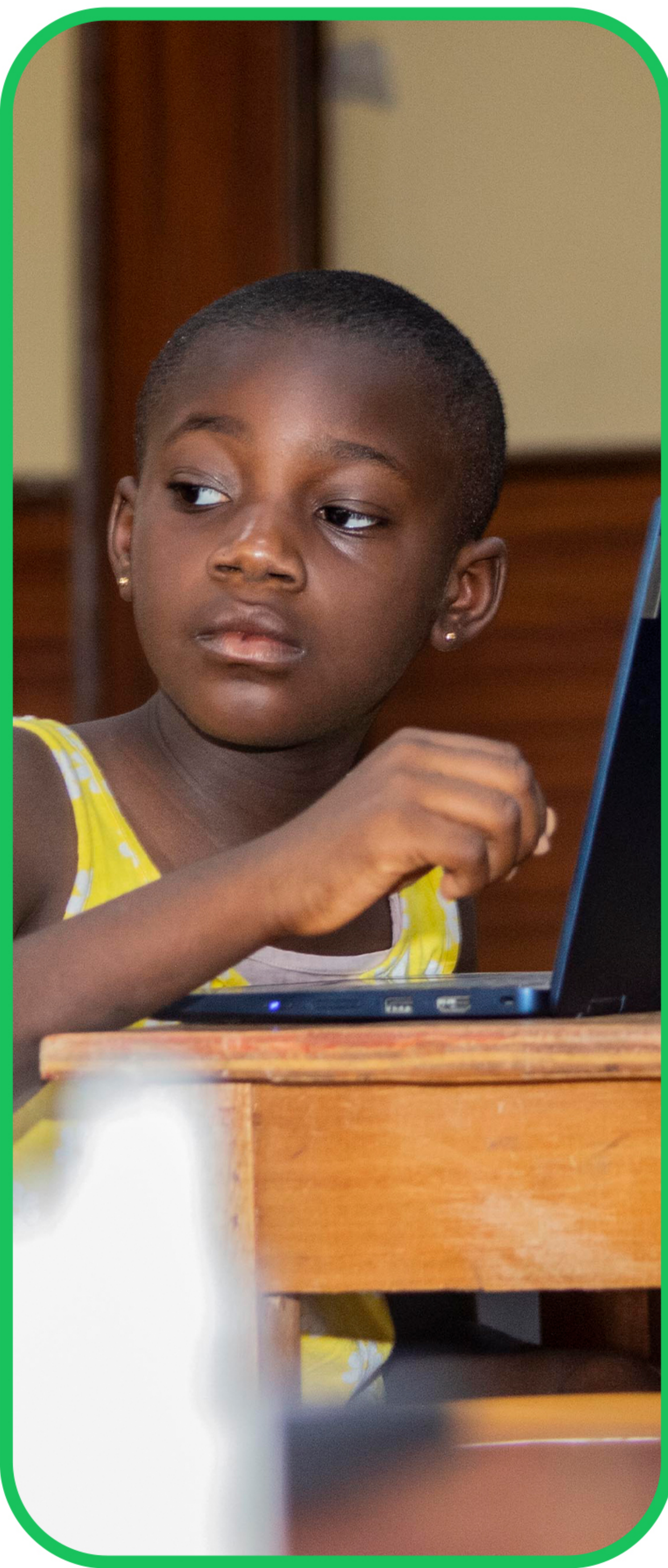
Salaries: A total of \$591.00 was allocated to cover the monthly salaries of five dedicated staff members.

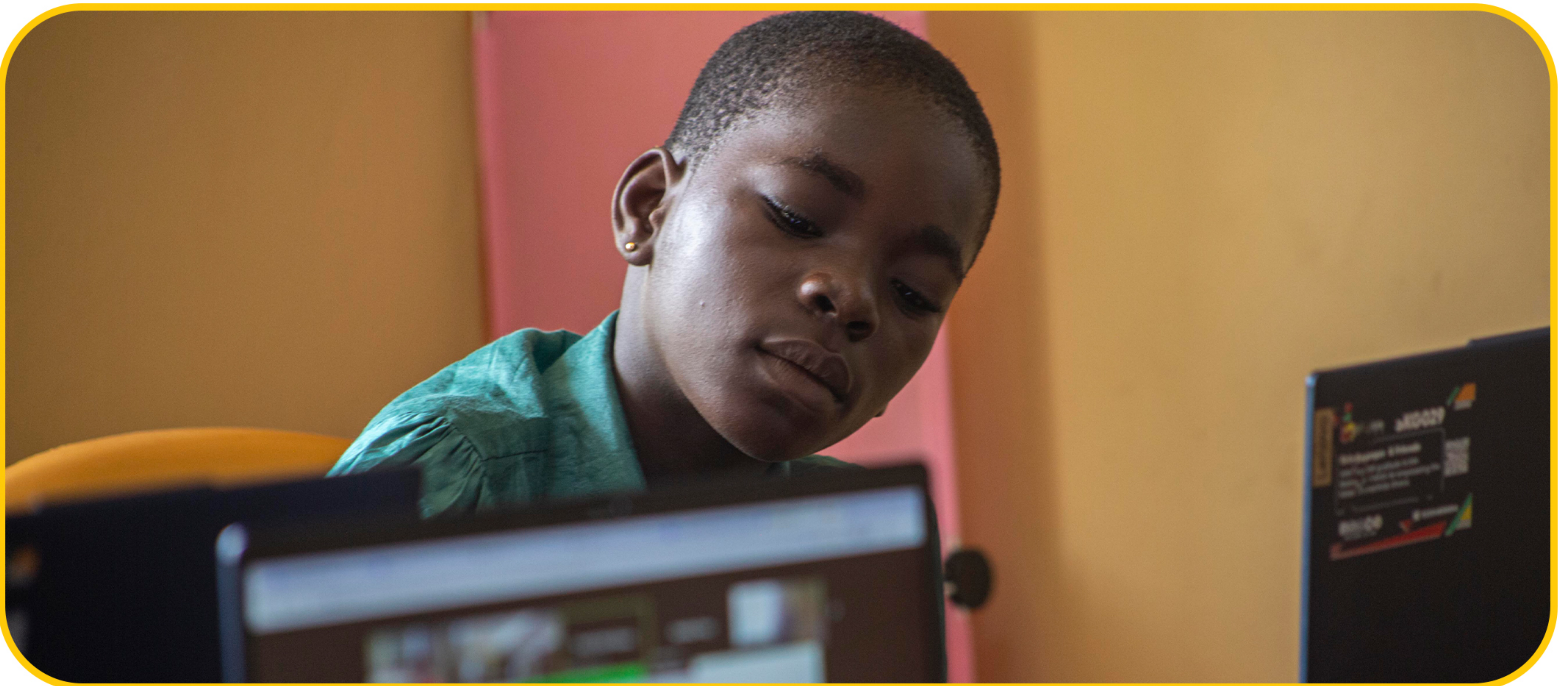


Student Ambassadors' Funds
