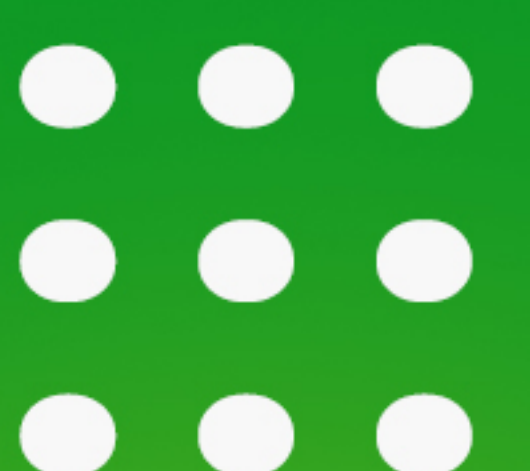
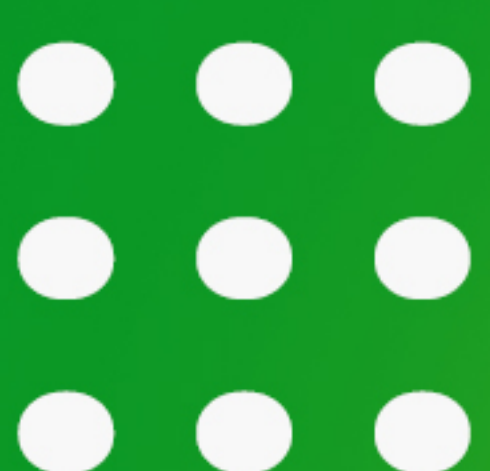

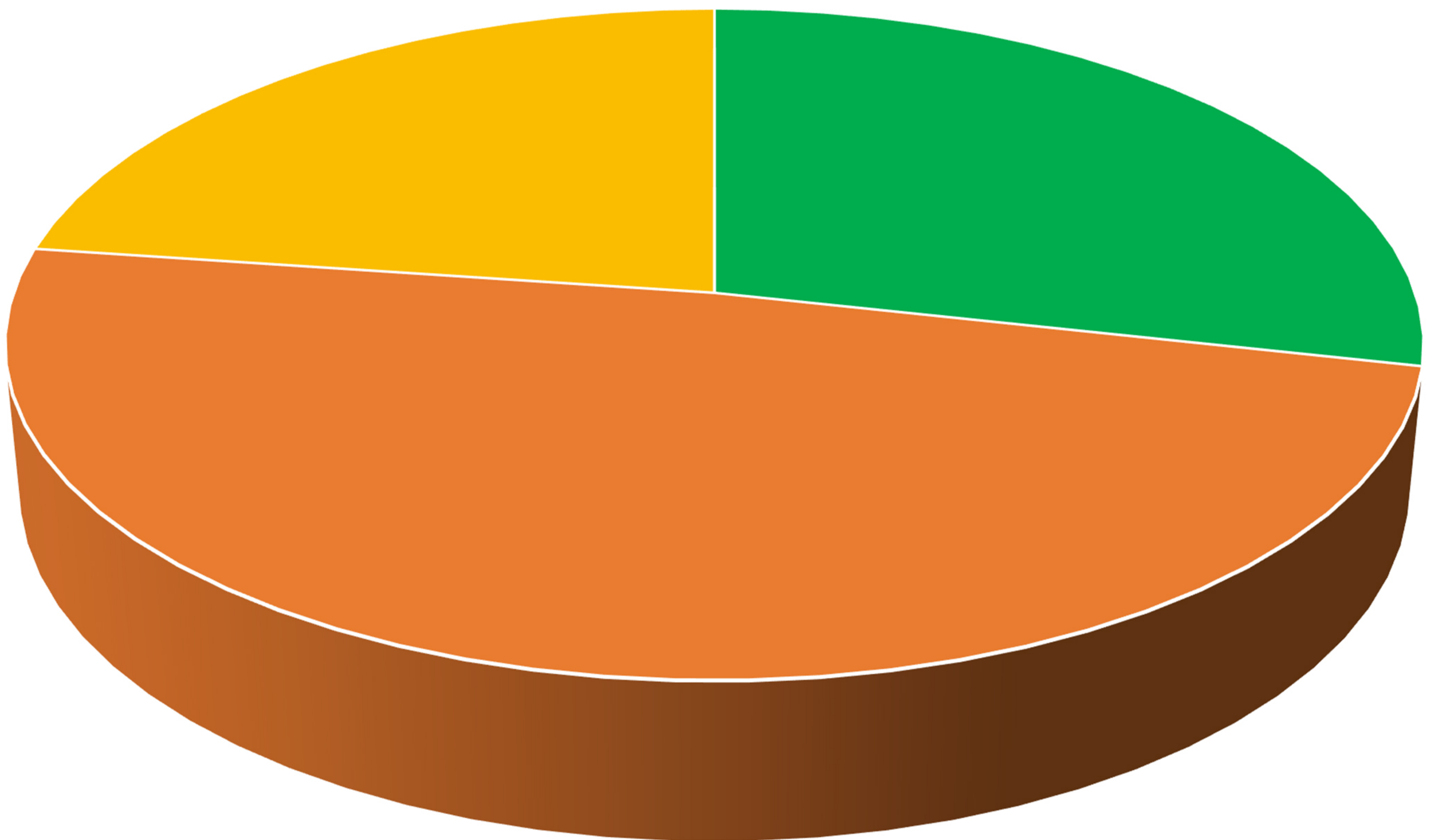

While we did not receive any new donations toward the bus fund in May, we remain hopeful and committed to achieving this important milestone. We have generated





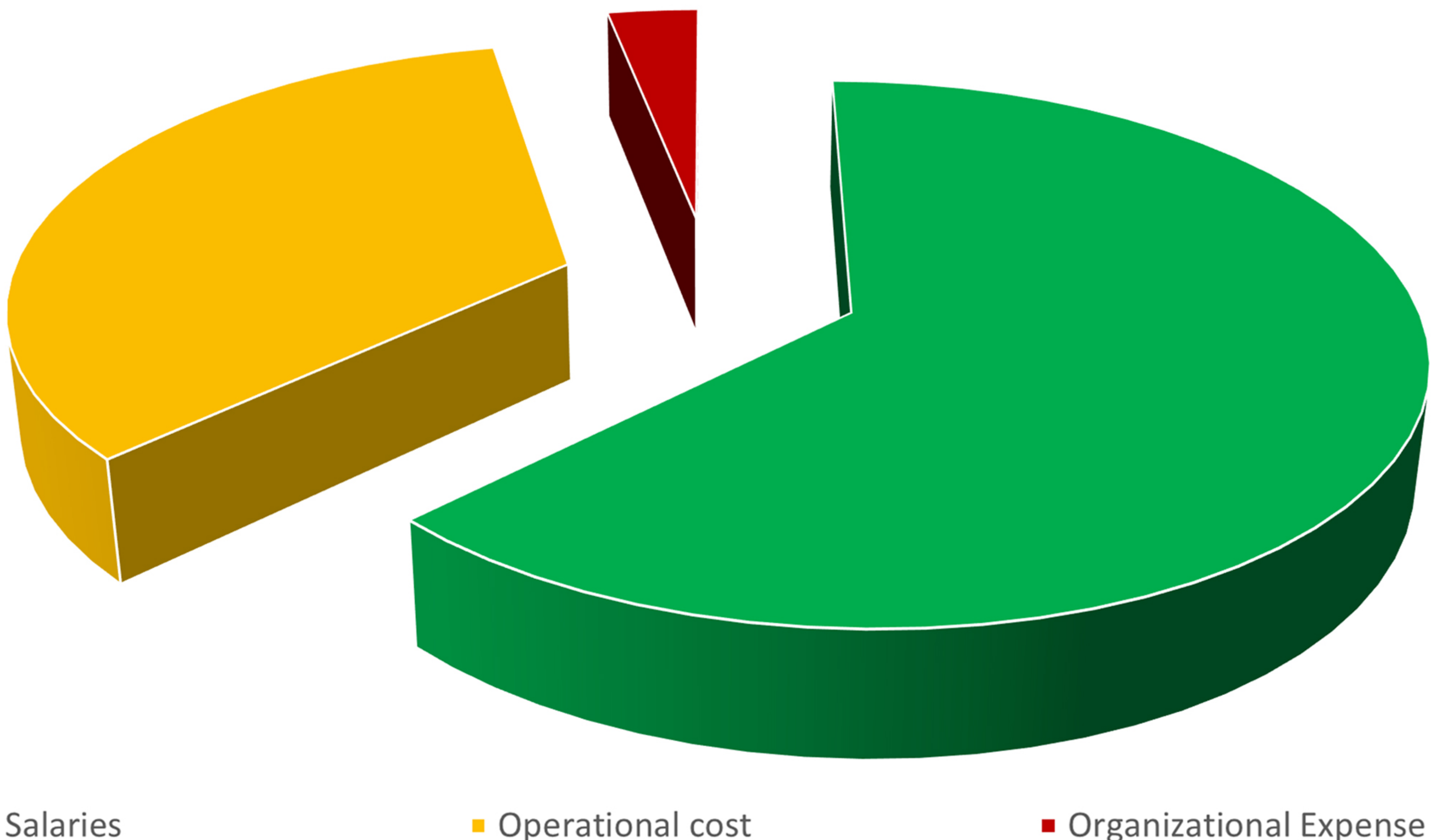

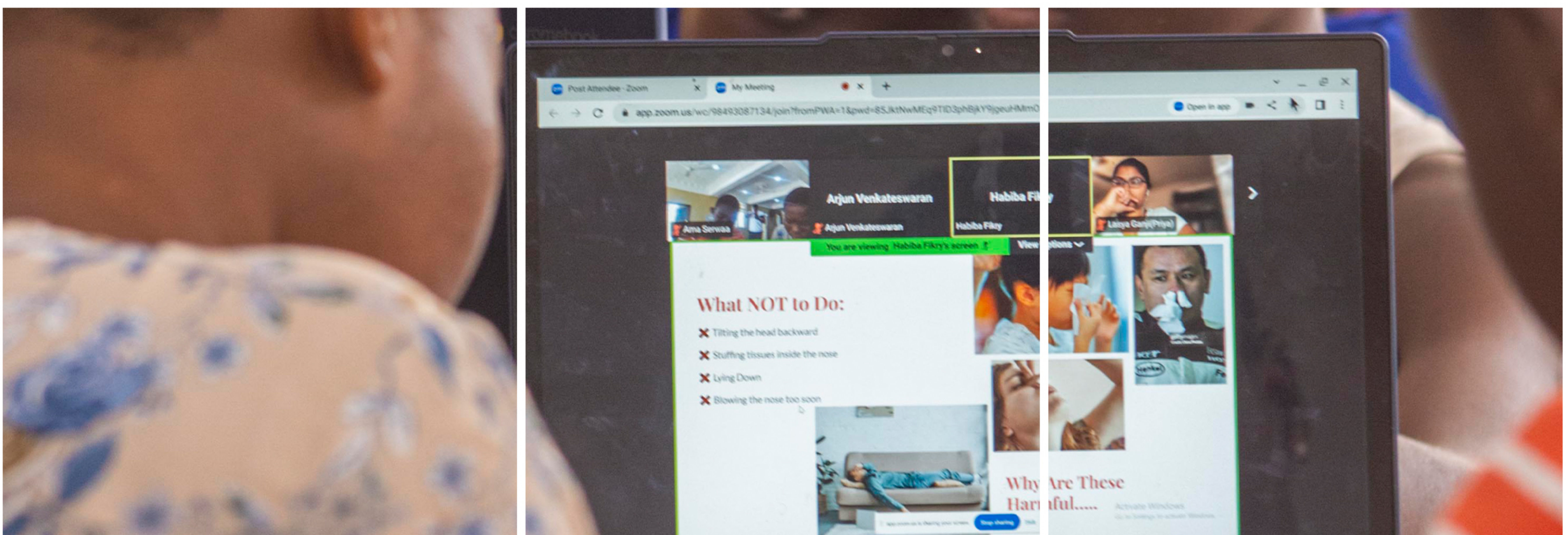
