### Ayeduase Introductory Trip – GHS 1,200.00

#### Monthly Official Trips – GHS 500.00

This covers administrative travel by the SmartKids Ghana leadership team to manage partnerships, meet with school leaders, and monitor program progress. These trips are essential for long-term planning and oversight.

#### St. Theresa Expenses – GHS 1,260.00

Weekly sessions at St. Theresa included educational support, lessons, and logistical coordination. Funds were used for transportation, student materials, and volunteer facilitation continuing our consistent presence and impact in the school.

#### Headphones (50 pieces) – GHS 1,000.00

To enhance virtual learning and Zoom sessions, 50 headphones were purchased and distributed to students. This investment in digital access is part of our broader commitment to tech-assisted learning and equity.

# Data Bundle – Nana Ama (GHS 250.00) & Bismark (GHS 350.00)

Monthly internet support for two of our local team members, Nana Ama and Director Bismark, enabled smooth coordination, virtual meetings, and the effective operation of our organization. These bundles are vital for efficient operations in a blended learning environment.
