This report summarizes Ghana-based operational expenses for June 2025. June marked the continuation of our regular education and outreach programs, alongside the introduction of a new initiative, the Esase Summer Lesson Pilot. Our consistent trips, staff support, and student events helped keep our communities engaged and motivated.

Activity Descriptions

Trip Cost to Ayeduase Lesson Center – GHS 1,200.00

Funds covered weekly transportation to our Ayeduase learning center for staff and volunteers. These trips enabled consistent mentoring and educational delivery to students in that area.

Monthly Staff Refreshment at Ayeduase – GHS 400.00

Light refreshments were provided for staff during weekly sessions at Ayeduase to support team motivation and maintain energy levels during their work with the scholars.

Trip Cost to St. Theresa's School – GHS 720.00

Weekly transportation to St. Theresa's ensured regular engagement, monitoring, and mentoring sessions, further strengthening our partnership with the school and deepening student support.

Monthly Trip Cost (Administrative/Monitoring Visits) – GHS 500.00

This covers administrative travel by the SmartKids Ghana leadership team to manage partnerships, meet with school leaders, and monitor program progress. These trips are essential for long-term planning and oversight.

Staff & Coordinators Refreshment at St. Theresa's – GHS 640.00

Refreshments were provided to staff and coordinators who dedicate time and effort to deliver weekly programming at St. Theresa's, encouraging consistency and boosting morale.

Esaase Summer Lesson Pilot – GHS 450.00

This was a key investment in June as we piloted our first Summer Lessons Program in Esaase. The amount covered the cost of logistics, materials, and staffing for the test phase of this new seasonal academic support initiative.

Monthly Birthdays – GHS 740.00

The June birthday celebration brought together students from multiple sites for a joyful gathering with food and gifts. These monthly events help build community and show appreciation for every child in the SmartKids family.

NB: All the above expenses are recorded as operational costs in our core financial records.
