












FEBRUARY Financial Report Ghana Expenses

Ayeduase Introductory Trip – GHS 1,200.00

Following January's initial outreach, February included four weekly visits to deepen engagement with the Ayeduase community. These visits supported student onboarding, teaching sessions, and meetings. Transportation, snacks, and learning aids were included in the cost.

This special event introduced SmartKids teaching methods and curriculum through a live demonstrative class at Amakom Vibe Montessori. It served as a showcase of our interactive approach, strengthening potential partnerships and increasing program visibility.

St. Theresa Expenses - GHS 1,260.00

Our continued weekly work at St. Theresa involved staff transportation, classroom materials, student lessons and direct engagement with teachers to support student progress.

Science Experiment Supplies – GHS 640.00

In February, we invested in materials for practical science experiments to enhance students' curiosity and understanding. These supplies were used across multiple sessions, sparking excitement and hands-on learning.

February Birthday Celebration – GHS 740.00

This one-time event celebrated students with birthdays in February across our Ghana communities. This event brought together SmartKids scholars for a fun, inclusive gathering with food, games, and gift packages. It created meaningful memories and reinforced community among students.
