Expense Descriptions



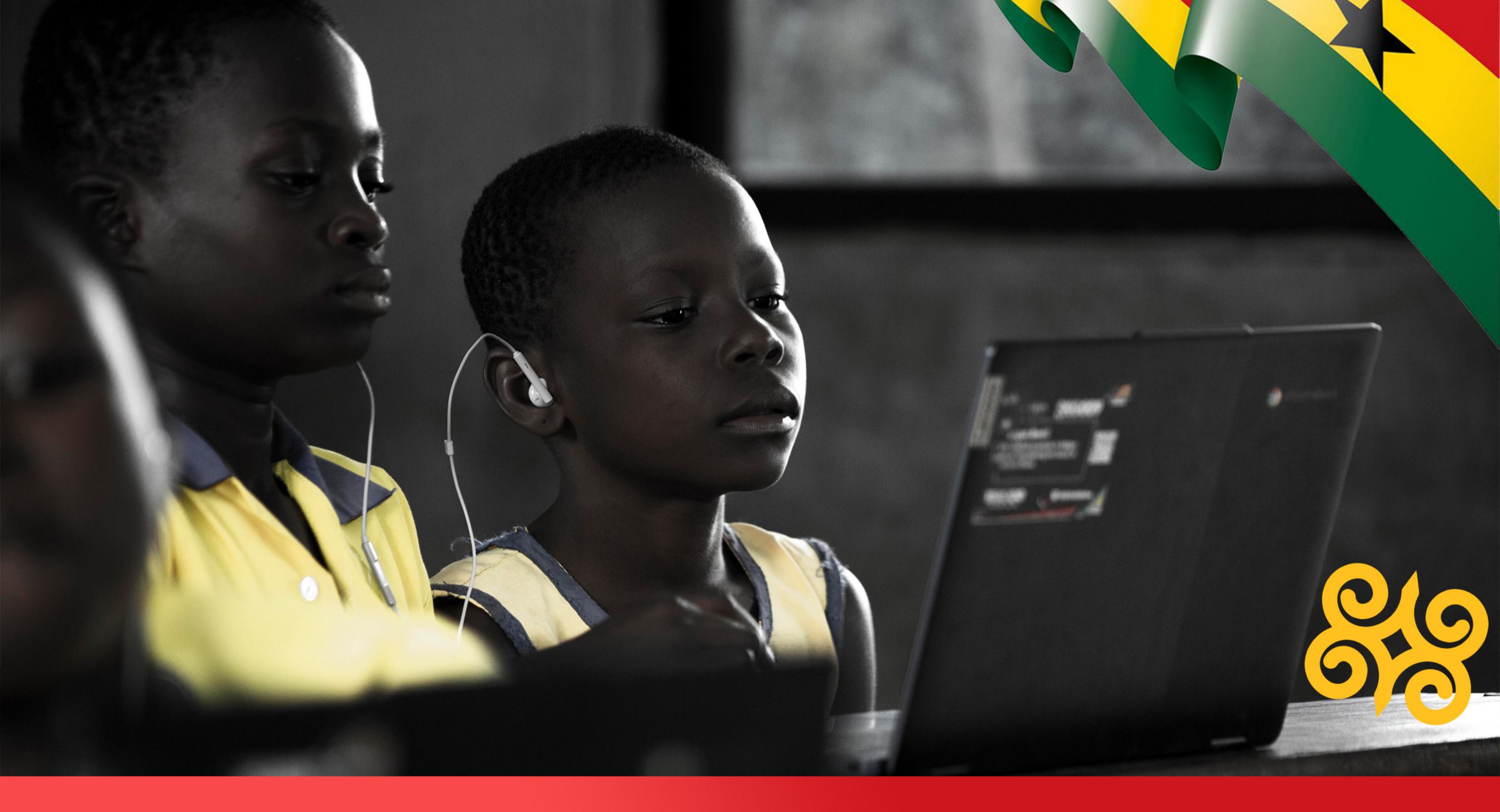
Transportation – GHS 1,600.00

Monthly Trip Cost - GHS 500.00

Administrative and monitoring trips allowed leadership to oversee program delivery, provide guidance to coordinators, and ensure smooth operations.

Staff & Coordinators Refreshment at Esaase – GHS 640.00

Light refreshments supported staff and coordinators during extended lesson hours, helping sustain energy and morale in the field.

Data Bundle and Airtime (Donor Relations & Finance) – GHS 500.00

Monthly internet and airtime support was provided for our Donor Relations and Finance associate. This ensured smooth communication with donors, accurate financial reporting, and effective coordination of activities.

Scholars' Snacks & Water - GHS 1,200.00

Nutritious snacks and water were provided to students during lessons. These small but vital provisions kept scholars energized and encouraged attendance.

Coordinators' Stipends – GHS 300.00

Modest stipends supported local coordinators who managed attendance, logistics, and communication. Their dedication ensured smooth program delivery on the ground.
