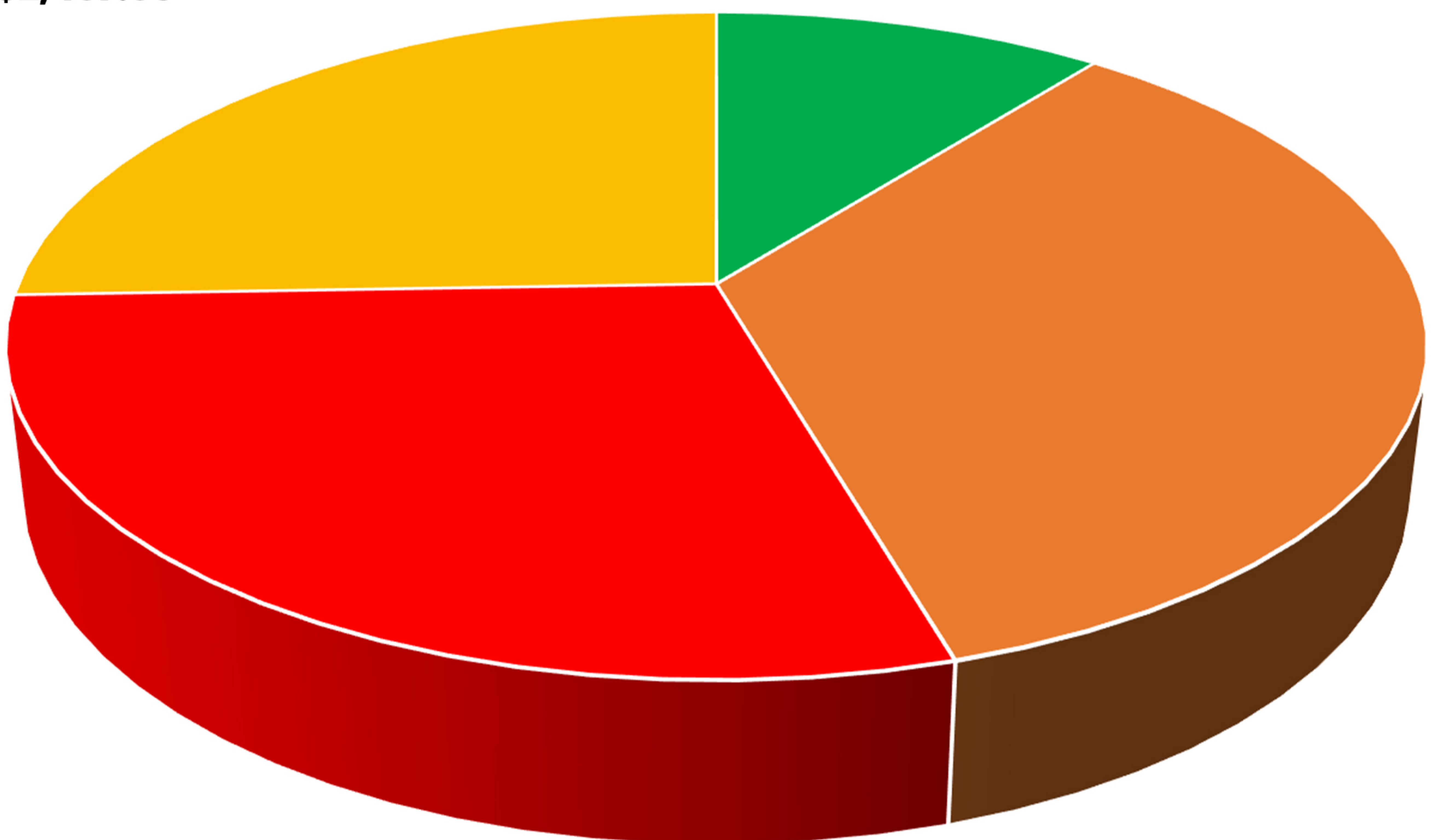

BUS FUNDRAISING

Two months ago, SmartKids Ghana launched the Mobile Learning & Health Van Initiative, an ambitious and transformative project designed to bring education and basic health resources directly to underserved children and communities across Ghana. This initiative aims to acquire and equip a **15–20 seater van** that will function as a Mobile Learning and Health Resource Center, the first of its kind in Ghana.

This multipurpose van will be fitted with:

First-aid and basic health teaching equipment

Laptops with a mobile charging unit

Science experiment kits with safe, organized storage



By bringing educational materials and health awareness directly to children where they are, this initiative will bridge critical gaps in access, opportunity, and well-being. It represents a scalable, community-centered model that supports the rights of every child to learn, explore, and thrive.

Since launching, we have been reaching out to supporters through personalized emails, newsletters, and social media campaigns, as well as engaging our previous donors and student ambassadors who have consistently uplifted our mission. So far, we have received **\$500** toward our **overall goal of \$26,000**.

While progress has been slow, our determination has not wavered. We remain fully committed to making this vision a reality and ensuring that children across Ghana continue to receive quality learning opportunities regardless of their financial capabilities. As we move forward, we're inviting compassionate donors to stand with us. By welcoming at least 10 new supporters this month, we can raise an additional \$2,000 and continue building momentum toward our goal.

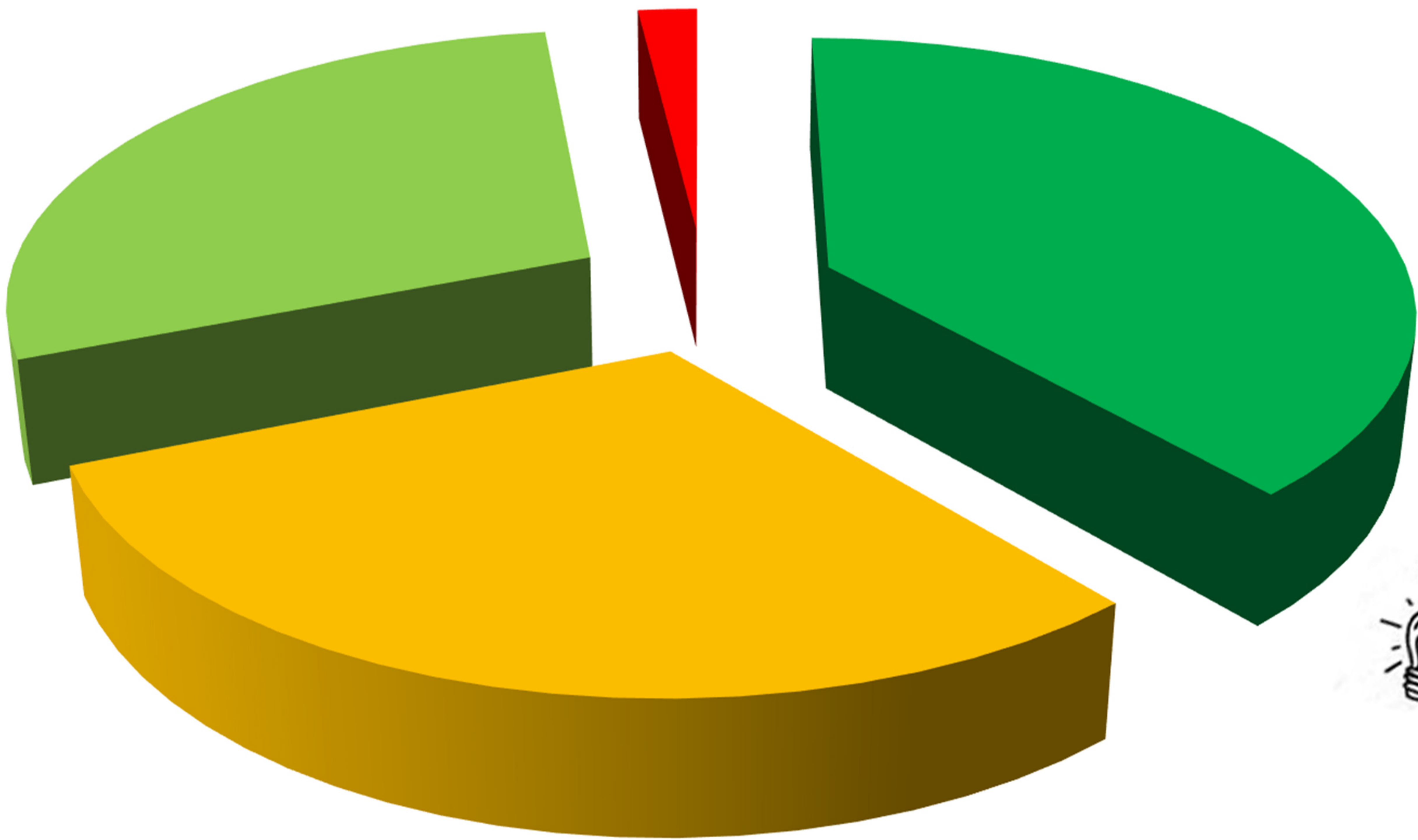
For the month of November, our total expenditure amounted to \$2,131.05, thoughtfully distributed across essential operational areas to enhance efficiency and sustain meaningful impact.

A Deeper Look at Expenses

Salaries: A total of \$825.00 was allocated to cover the monthly salaries of four dedicated staff members.

Operational Costs: An amount of \$645.00 was used to support the organization’s day-to-day activities in Ghana. These costs included office supplies and other general overhead expenses. While the majority of funds are directed toward program implementation, operational expenses remain vital for maintaining smooth and effective operations.

Organizational Equipment: The organization incurred equipment-related expenses this year, including the shipping costs for all laptops purchased as part of routine operational needs. In addition, a replacement phone was acquired for the International Relations Manager to ensure continuity of communication and support for international activities. These expenditures reflect the organization's ongoing investment in essential technology and equipment to maintain effective operations.



Organizational Expenses: This month's organizational spending covered essential services and compliance-related fees necessary for ensuring smooth administrative operations and meeting regulatory requirements. A detailed breakdown of these expenses is provided below

Being part of the November Zoom lessons has been one of the best learning experiences, I gained new skills and felt supported. SmartKids Ghana has helped me believe more in myself.

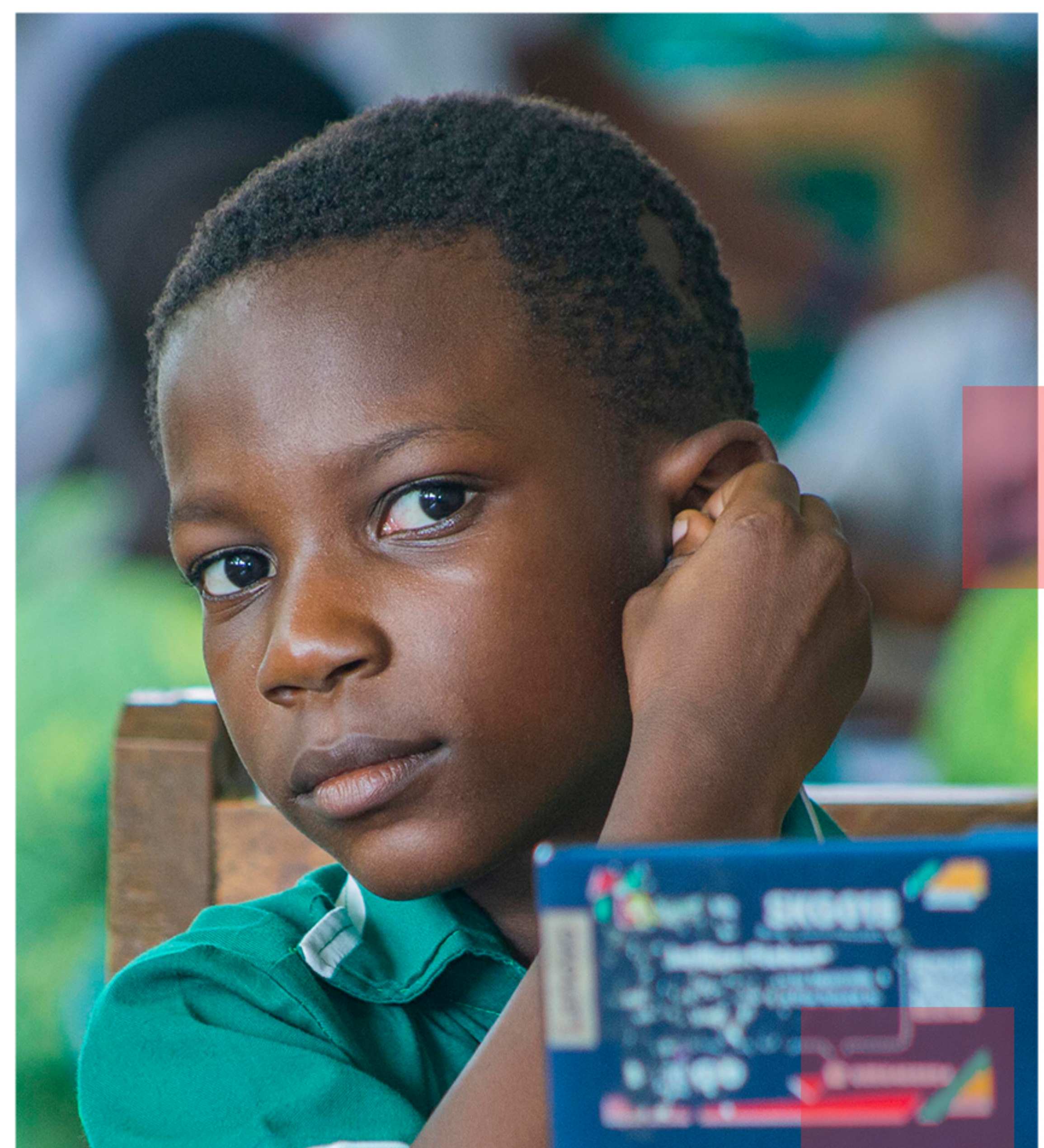
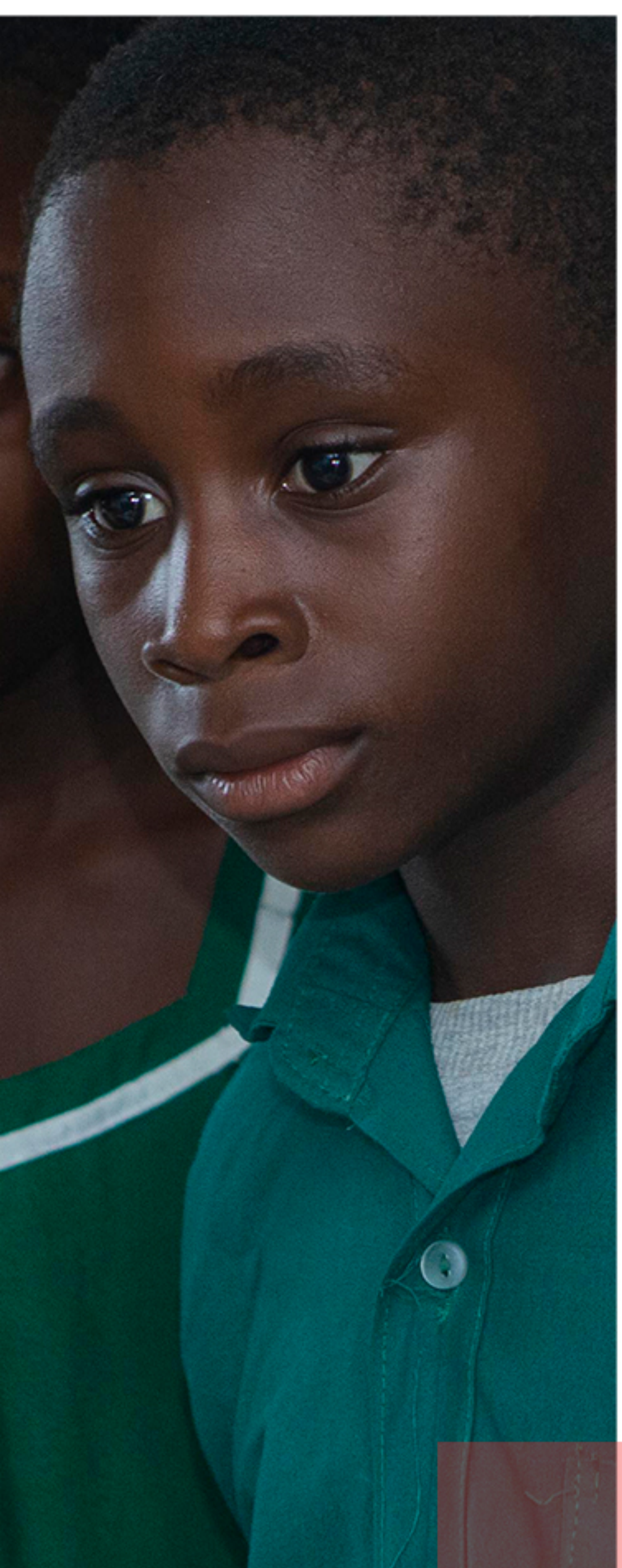

In total, we conducted 8 hours of Zoom teaching, 6 hours in November and an additional 2 hours scheduled for Saturday, December 6. Thirty scholars were enrolled in the program, with weekly attendance recorded as 30 in the first week, 28 in the second week, and 27 in the third week. The final session will take place on December 6, where we hope to see full attendance from all 30 scholars.

STUDENT AMBASSADOR RECRUITMENT

In November, SmartKids Ghana focused on strengthening internal systems across all ambassador programs, and as a result no new ambassadors were recruited during this month. The Student Ambassador, Junior Curriculum Ambassador, Laptop for Scholars Ambassador, and Zoom Teacher Ambassador programs all used the period to evaluate current performance, refine operational guidelines, and enhance support for existing ambassadors. This intentional pause allowed teams to improve curriculum modules, review ambassador engagement, assess laptop allocation and usage, and complete the final lessons of the November Zoom Cohort, which officially concludes on 6th December 2025, marking the end of the 2025 Zoom Teaching Program.

Although recruitment did not take place, November was a productive month dedicated to preparation and long-term planning. Each ambassador program concentrated on strengthening structures, gathering insights, and improving processes ahead of the next recruitment phase in 2026. These efforts ensure that SmartKids Ghana continues building high-quality ambassador teams capable of delivering stronger leadership, improved learning experiences, and greater impact for scholars across the country.

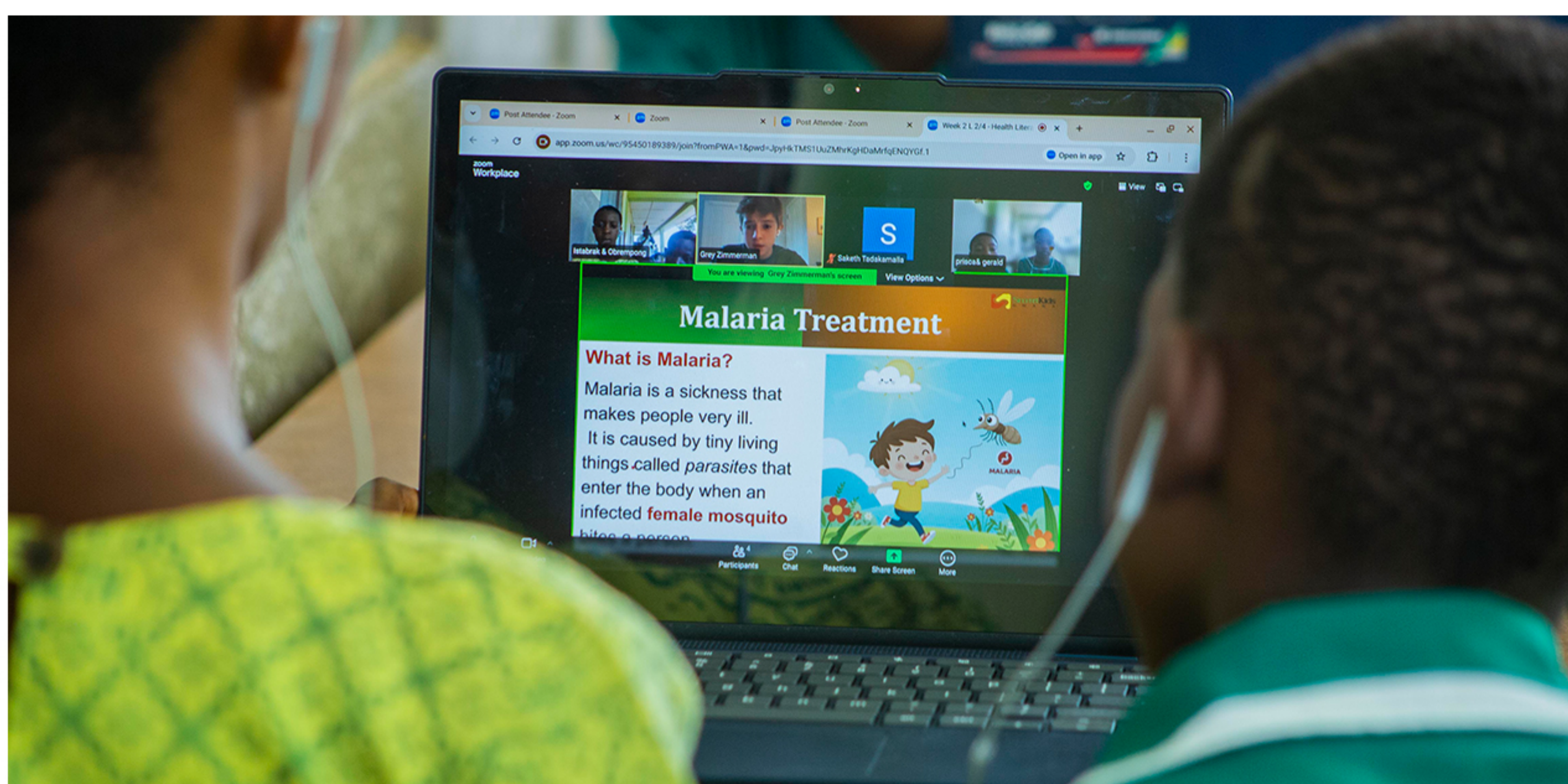

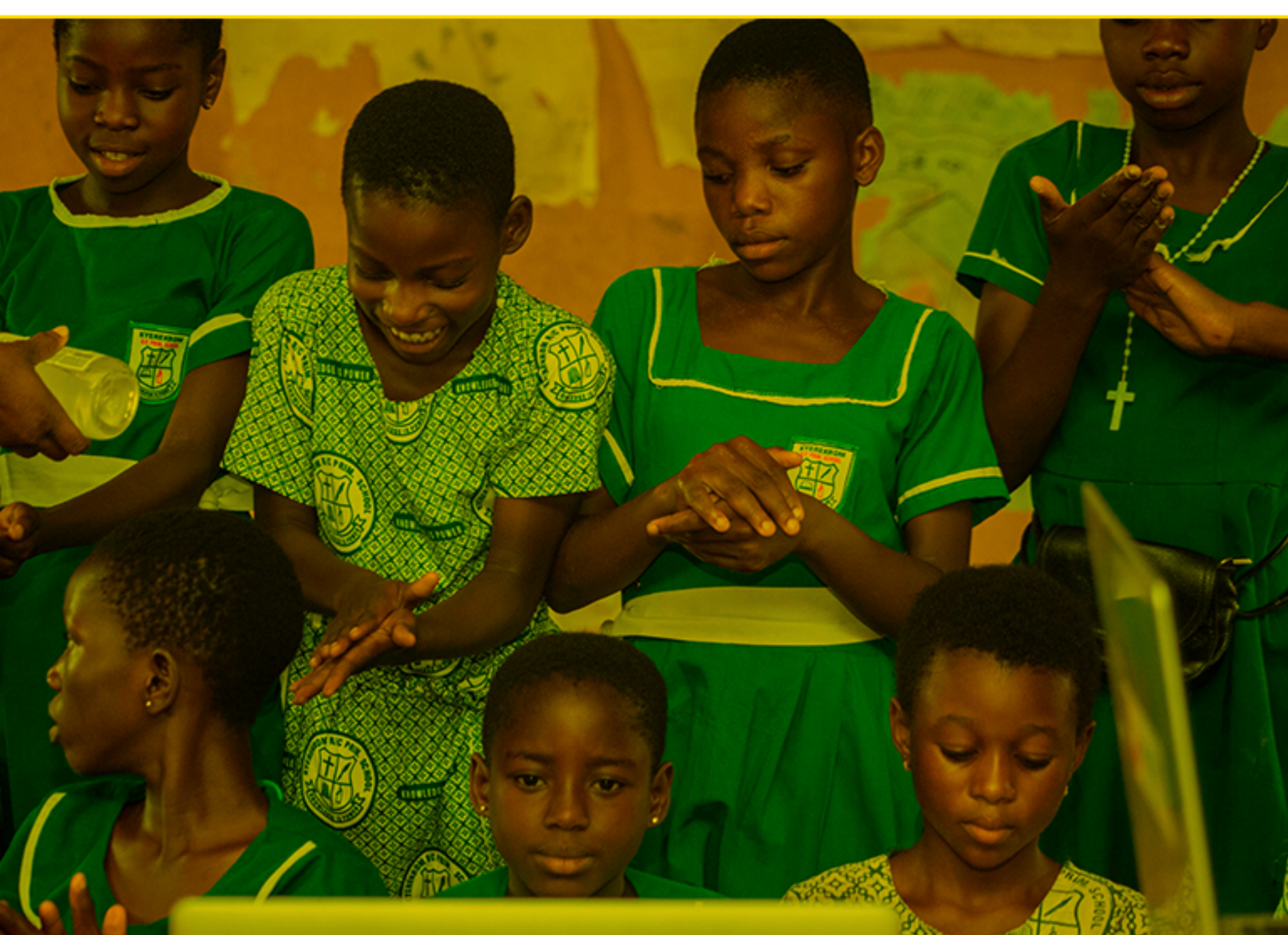
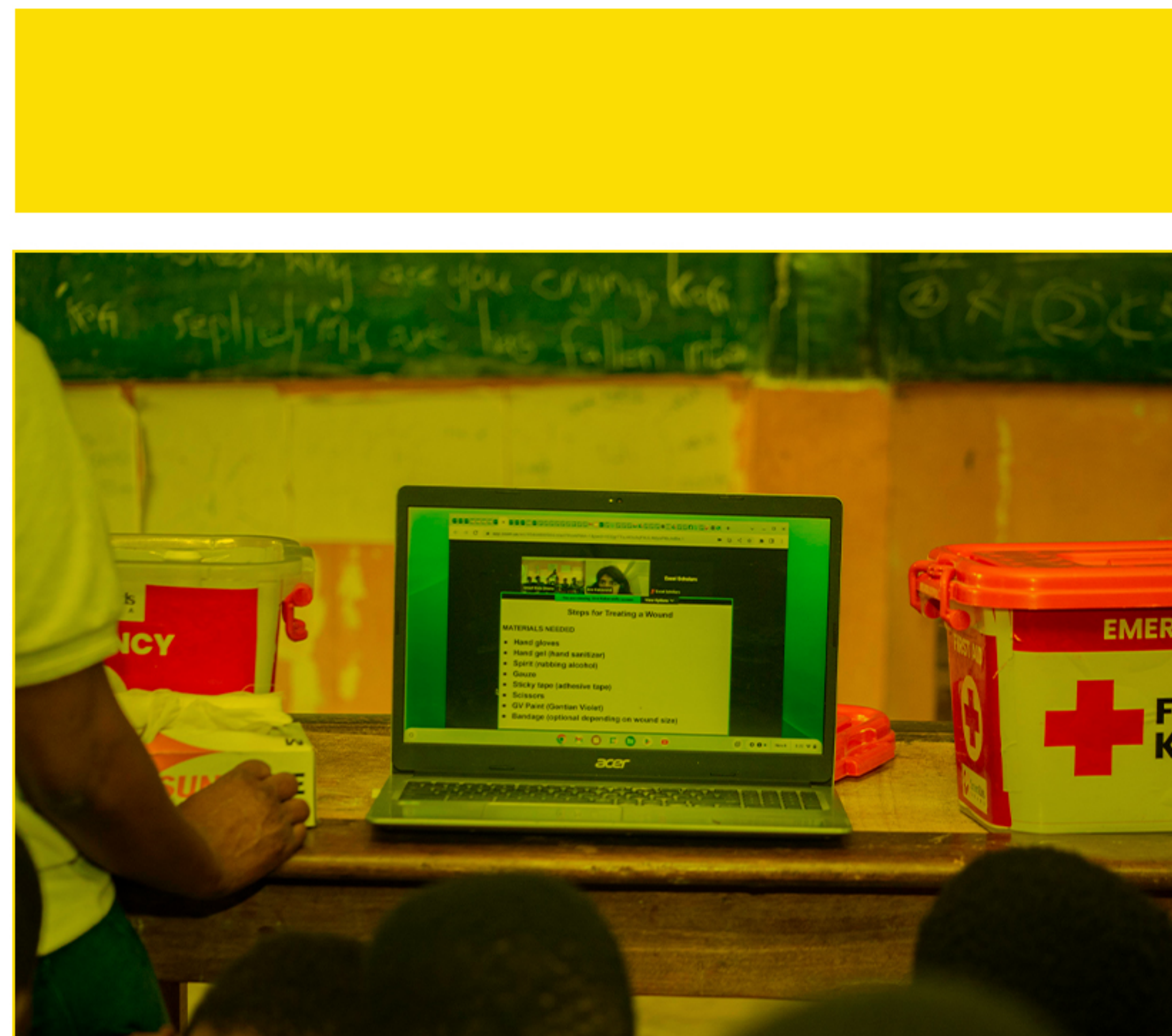
