




SmartKids Ghana Financial Report for February 2026 Total Income Overview (ALL) Raised


Expenditure

In February, our total expenditure stood at \$1,164.96, which was strategically allocated across key operational areas to maximize impact.

A Deeper Look at Expenses

Salaries: A total of \$962.62 was allocated to cover the monthly salaries of five dedicated staff members.

Operational Costs: An amount of \$45.45 was used to support the organization's day-to-day activities in Ghana. These costs included transportation for office supplies, data for all staff and other general overhead expenses. Operational expenses remain vital for maintaining smooth and effective running of the organization.

Towards the end of February, SmartKids began a strategic collaboration with SmartKids Africa Club to establish a new SmartKids Africa Club at University of California, San Diego (UCSD), USA. This milestone marks the beginning of SmartKids' structured expansion across the globe and reflects our commitment to building a strong international support network for SmartKids Ghana.

The establishment of the clubs is designed to serve as sustainable, student-driven platforms that amplify our mission of providing educational access to underprivileged scholars in Ghana. 


Recruitment of Monthly Donors

As our first school partnership of the year, this milestone marks a strong and promising start to our program implementation cycle. It reflects both the growing trust in SmartKids Ghana's curriculum and our continued commitment to expanding access to quality educational and technology support for underserved communities. Through this collaboration, SmartKids will deliver structured virtual and in-person lessons, academic support, access to laptop devices, headsets, internet and mentorship sessions directly to students ensuring we bridge the gaps in educational access. The program will focus on core subjects; technology literacy, critical thinking and problem-solving skills, English literacy, health literacy, entrepreneurial skills and community projects. Our interactive learning experiences aim at improving academic performance, building confidence and equipping scholars with real-life skills.

We look forward to implementing our 21st-century curriculum and pedagogy at Adwumam R/C Basic School, marking an important step in advancing innovative teaching and bridging the digital education gap across Ghana.
