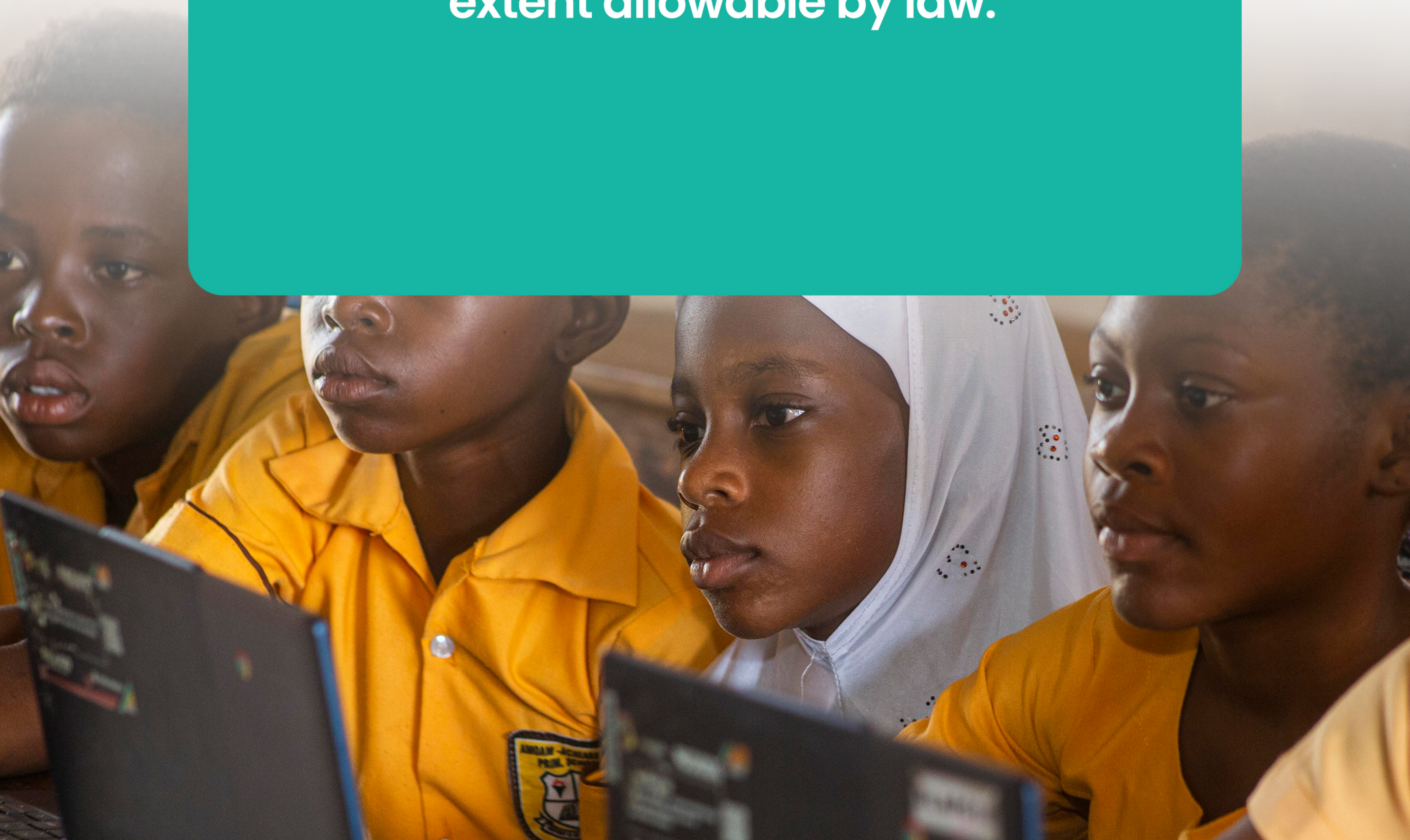

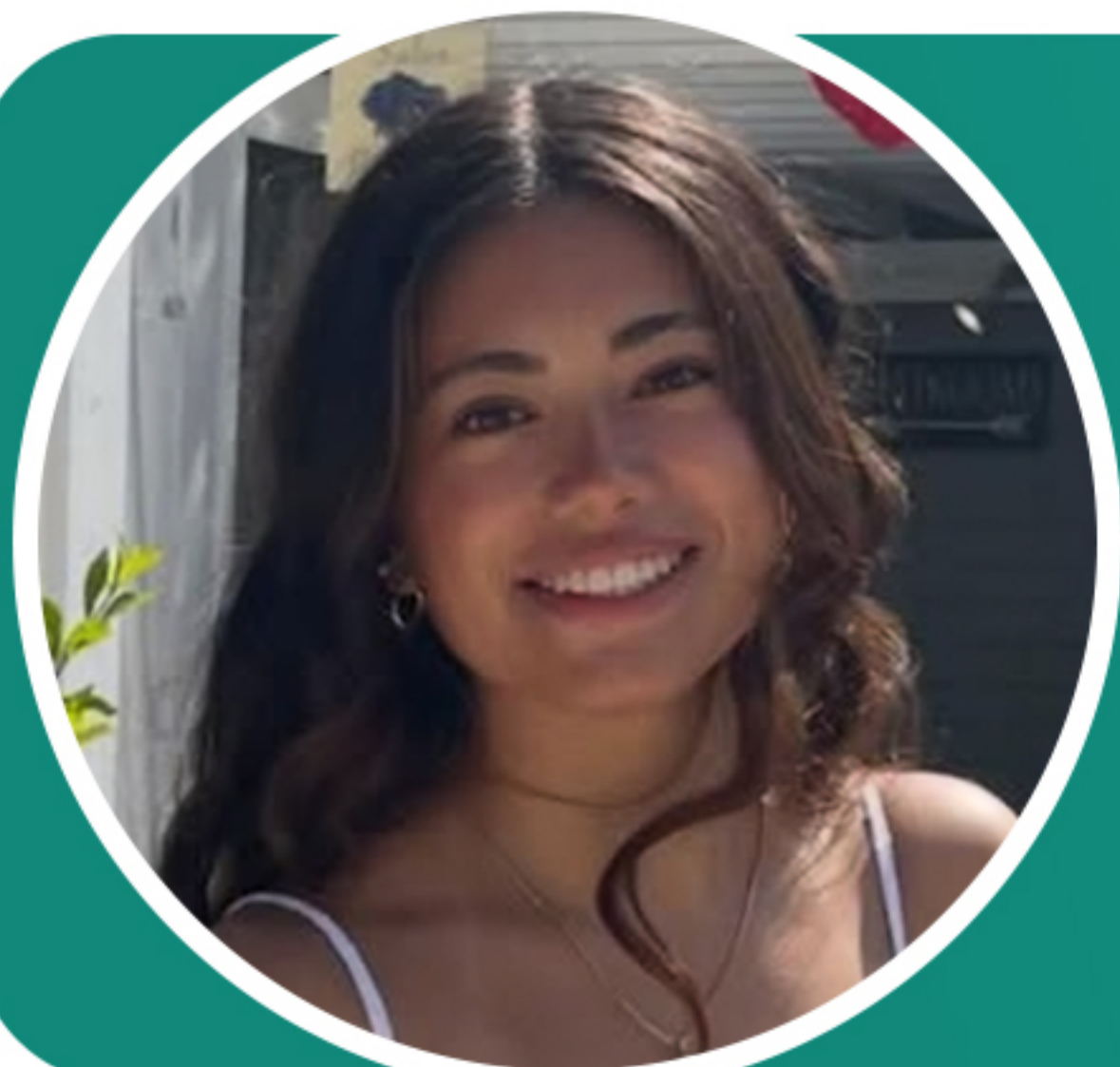

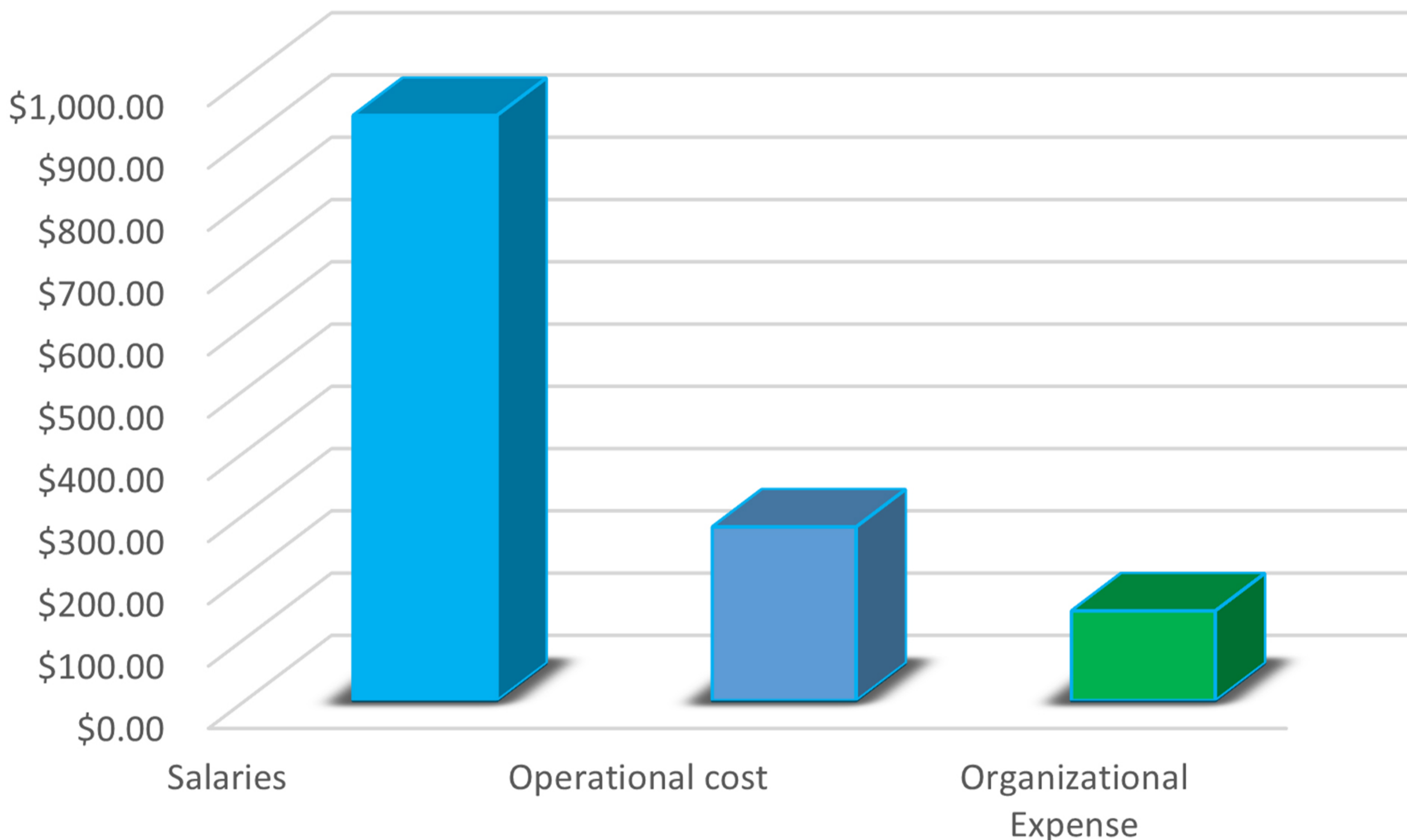
# SmartKids Ghana Financial Report For March 2026

### **A Deeper Look at Expenses**

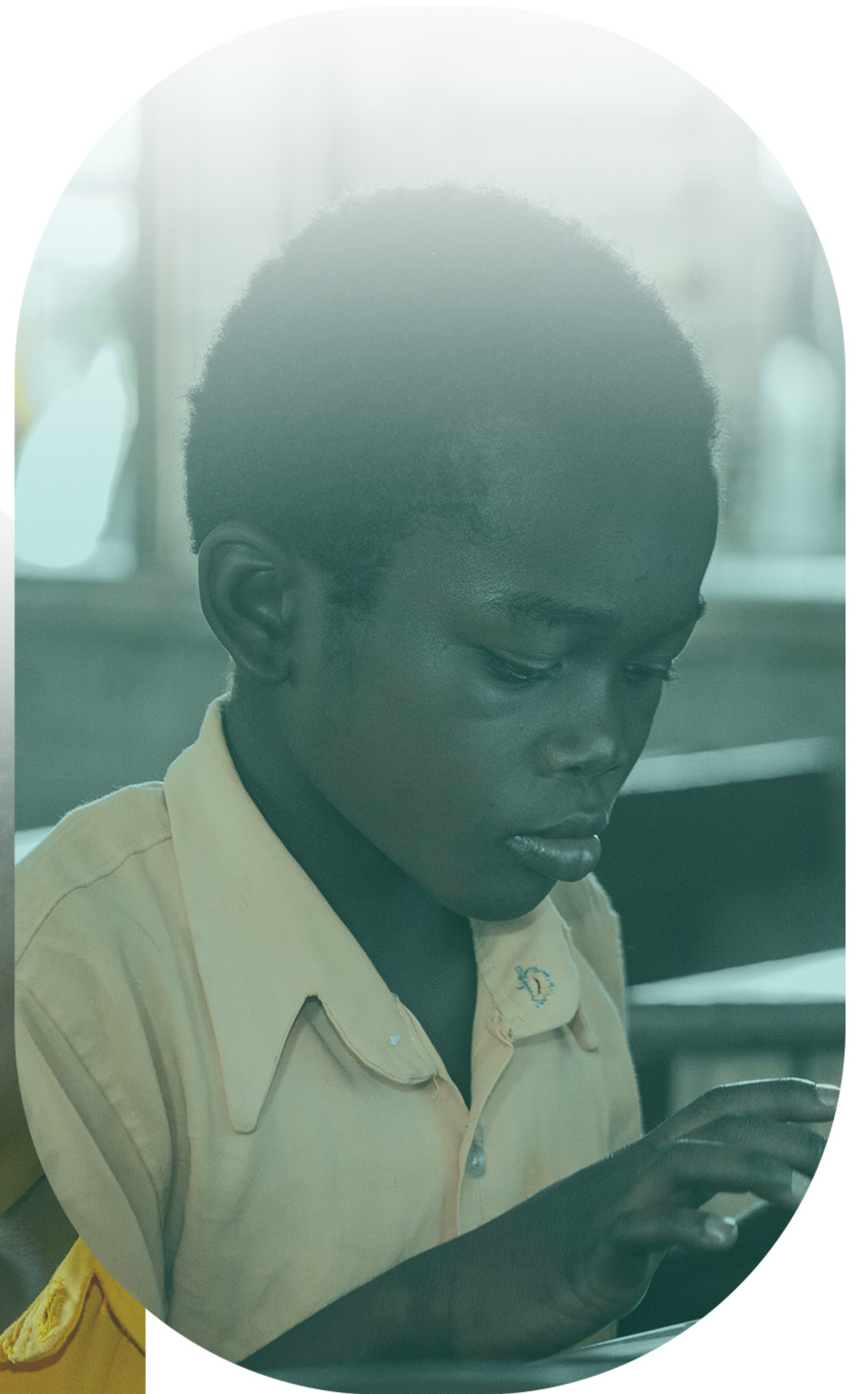
**Salaries:** A total of \$939.59 was allocated to cover the monthly salaries of five dedicated staff members.

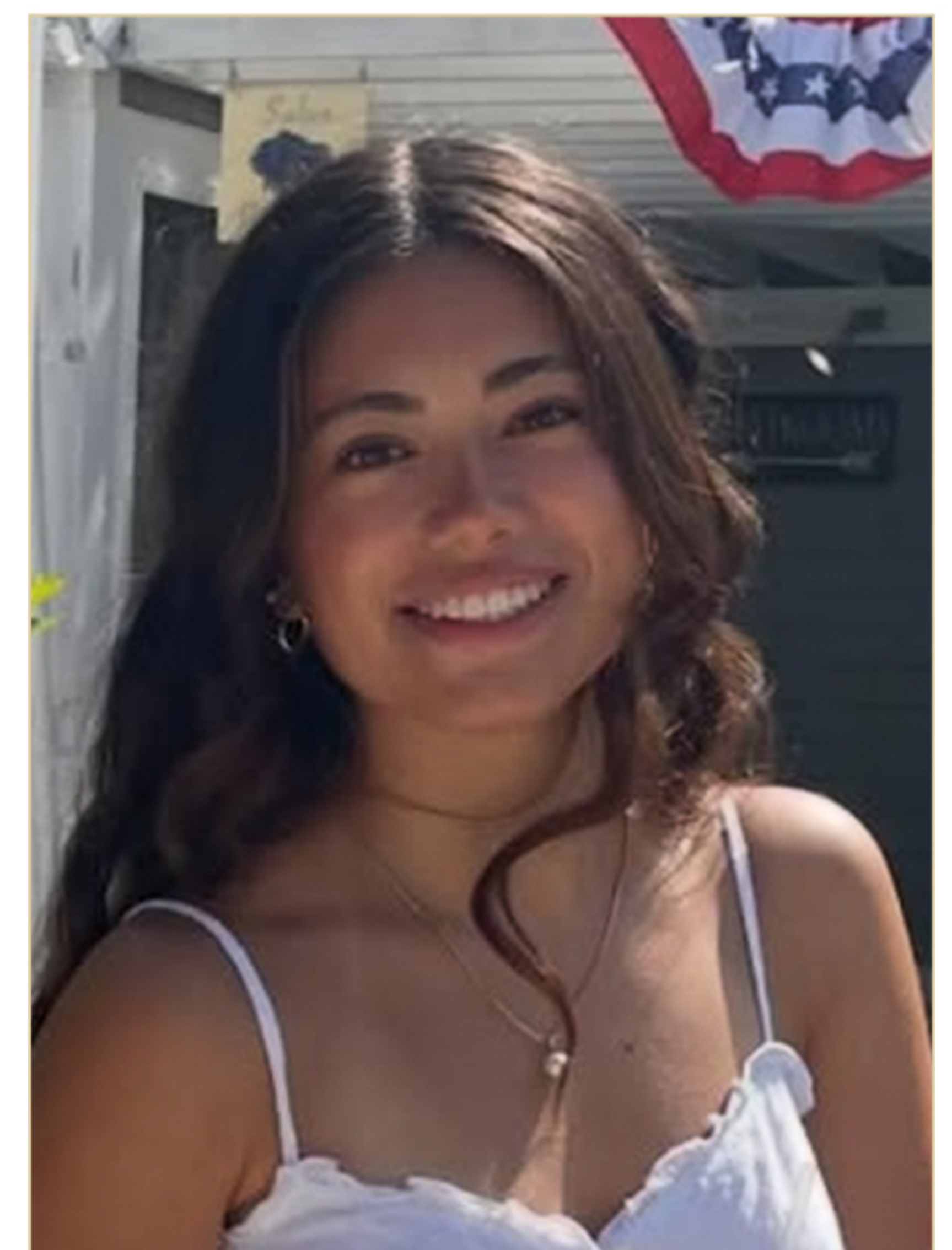

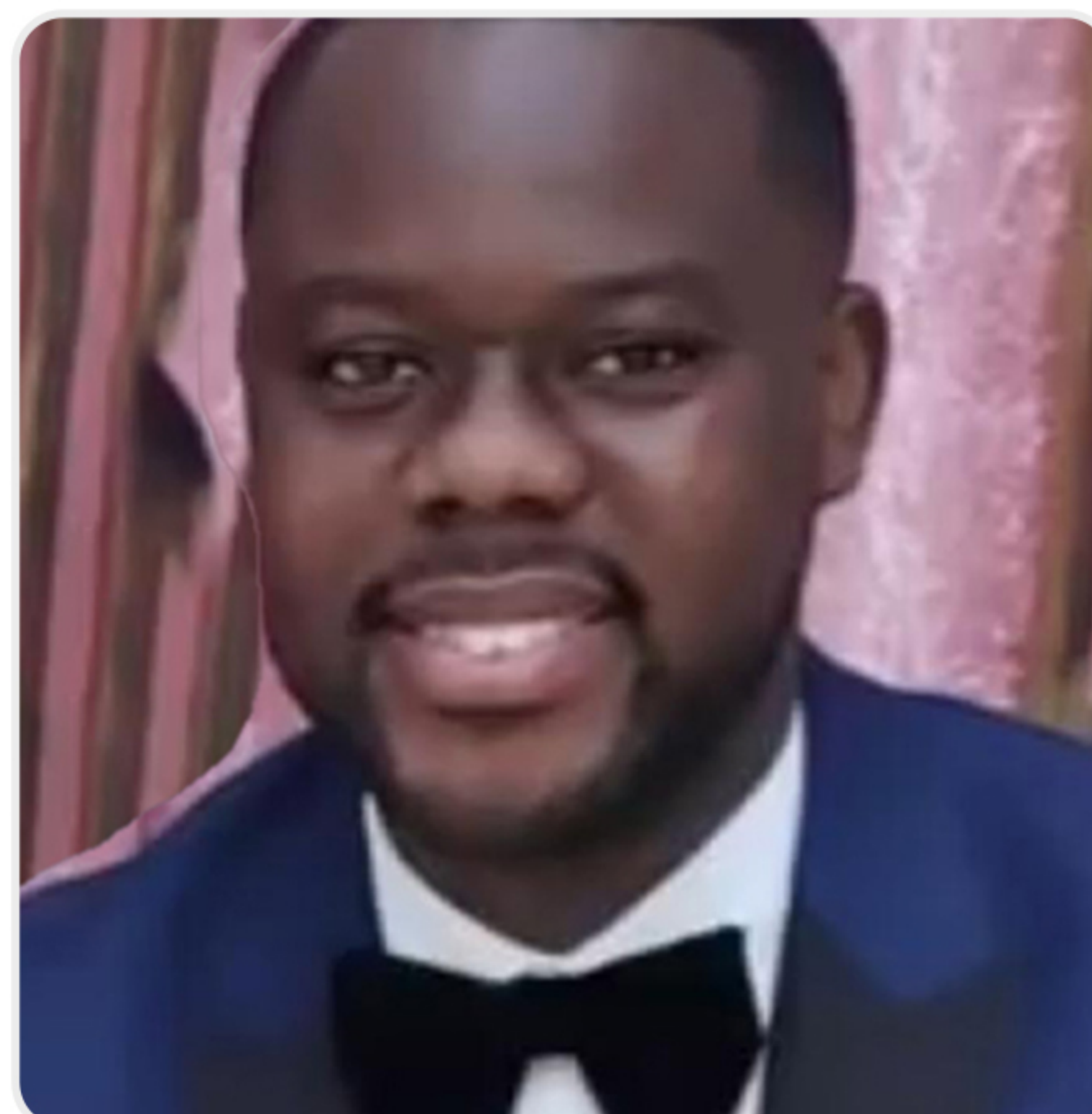


# MEET THE ADVISORY BOARD

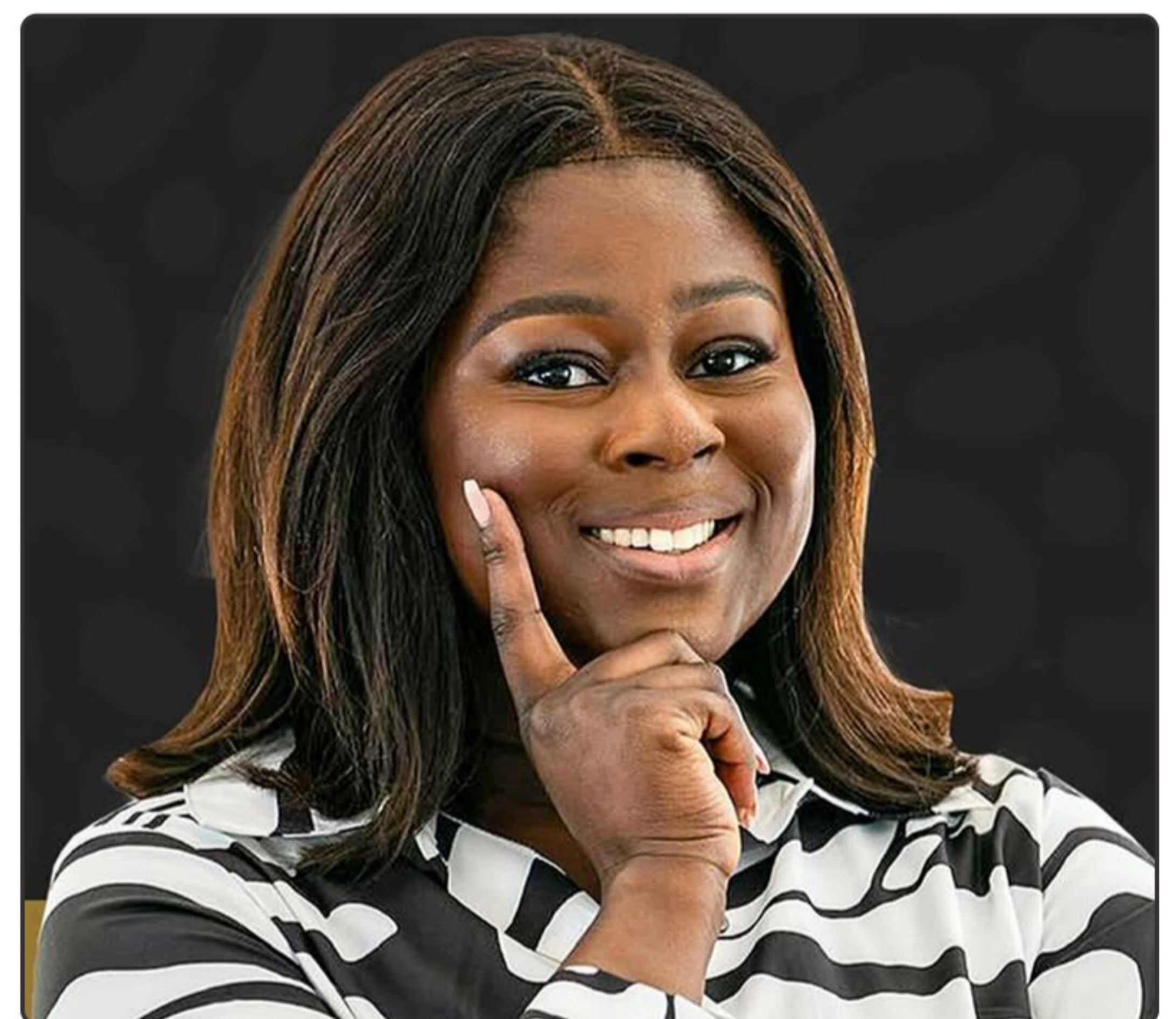
Each new donor represents a meaningful step forward, strengthening our ability to provide consistent, high-quality educational opportunities for our scholars.
