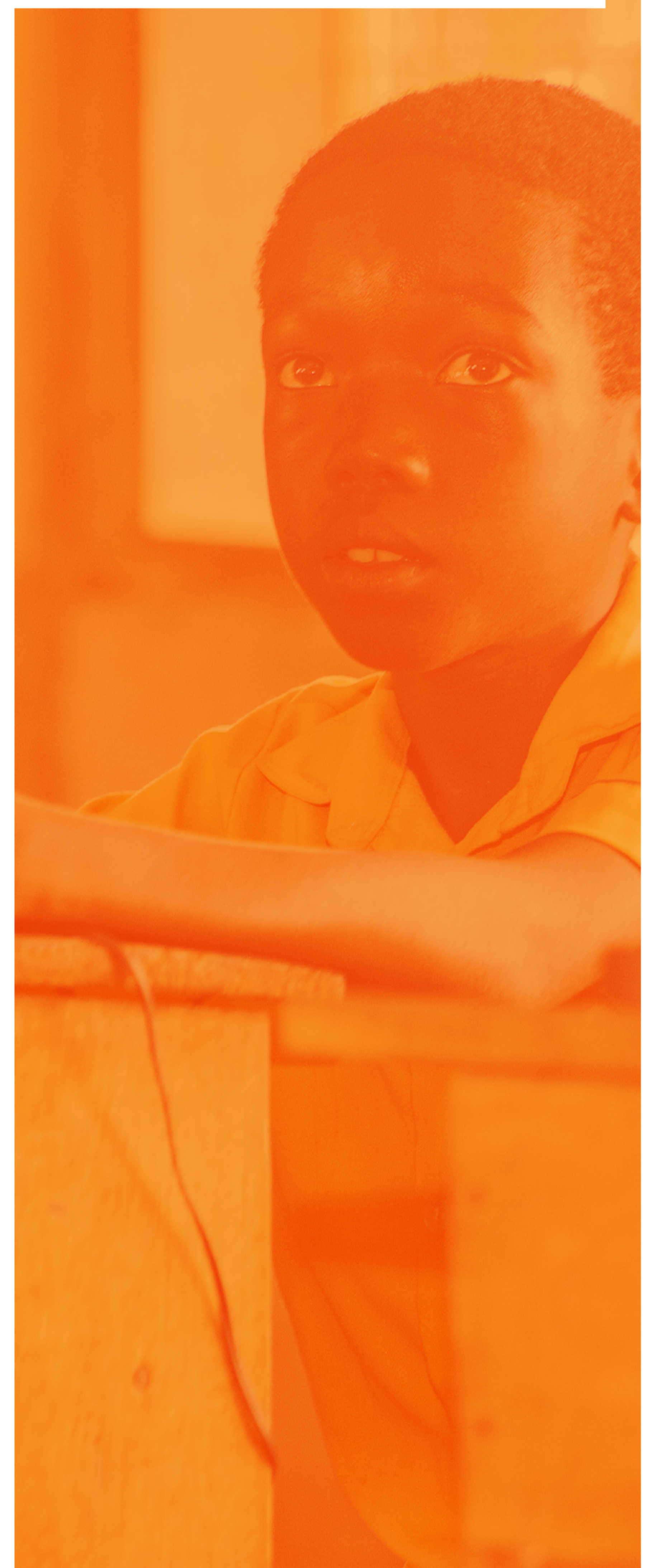

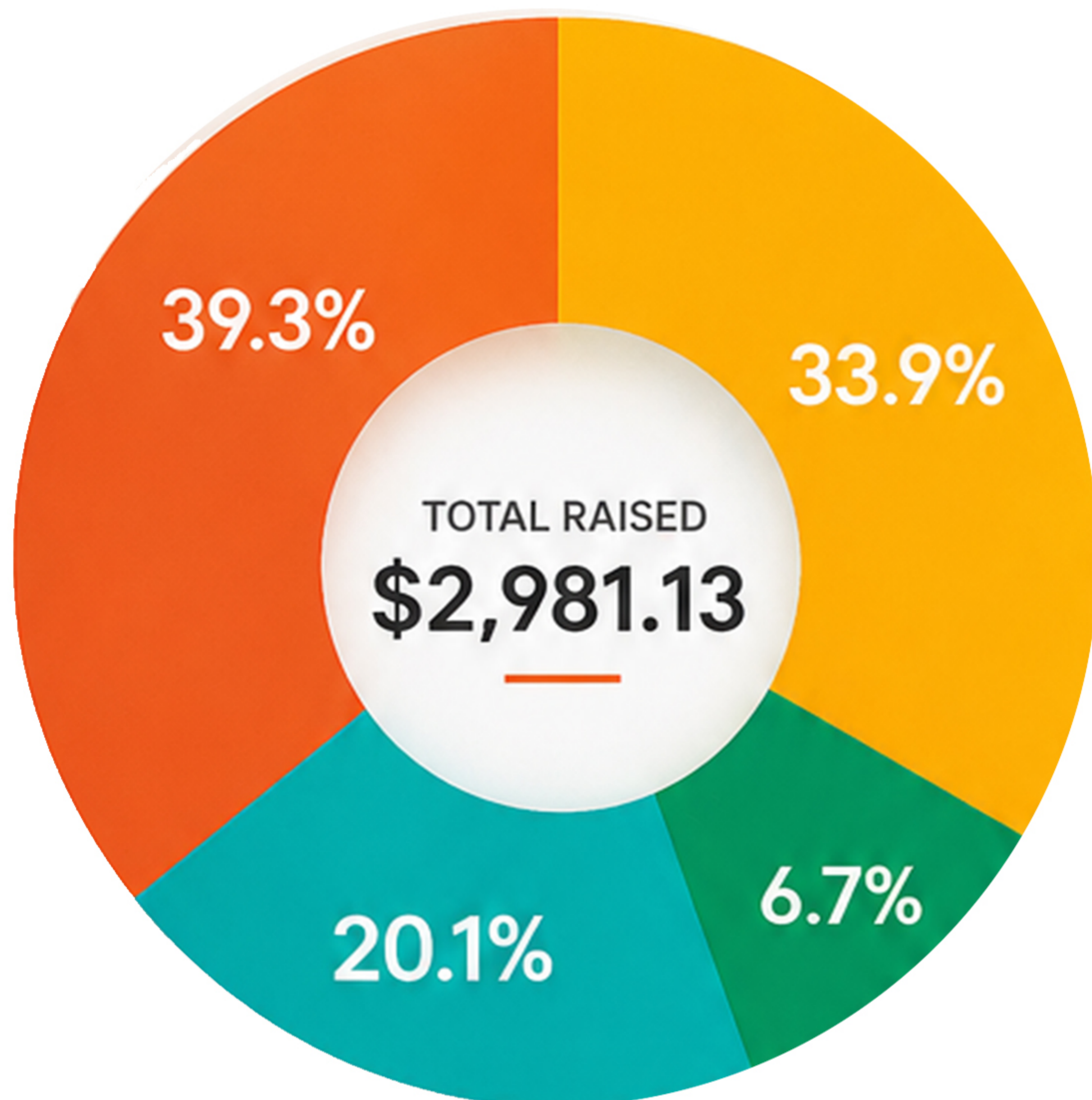
SmartKids Ghana Financial Report for April 2026 Total Income Overview (ALL) Raised

The Alumni Giving Circle Club will be launching a *Zoom-based teaching project* in July, aimed at strengthening our virtual learning program. This project will focus on enhancing lesson quality by equipping instructors with essential teaching materials such as calculators, stopwatches, protractors, and thermometers.



In preparation, the team will first meet with Director Bismark, our program director, to align on the curriculum they wish to teach and ensure that all materials effectively support lesson objectives. A general meeting with the wider team will follow, where a detailed overview of the project, including the fundraising strategy and financial plan, will be presented.

With the April 30 fundraising deadline approaching, we encourage continued support to help the Alumni Giving Circle Club reach their **\$2,000.00** target. Funds raised will cover the Zoom Teaching Lessons, the procurement of lesson implementation supplies, as well as shipping and transportation costs of supplies to Ghana, ahead of the July launch.

We are confident that this project will significantly enhance our Zoom teaching program and create a more engaging and impactful learning experience for our scholars.





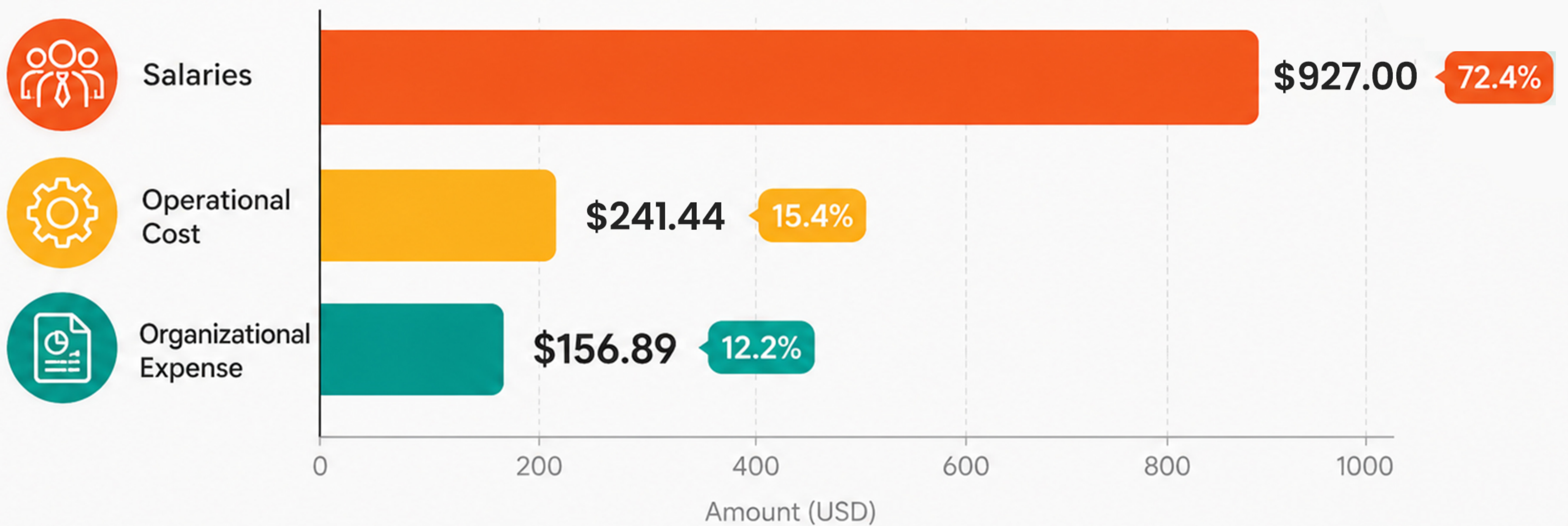

Salaries: A total of \$927.00 was allocated to cover the monthly salaries of Six dedicated staff members.

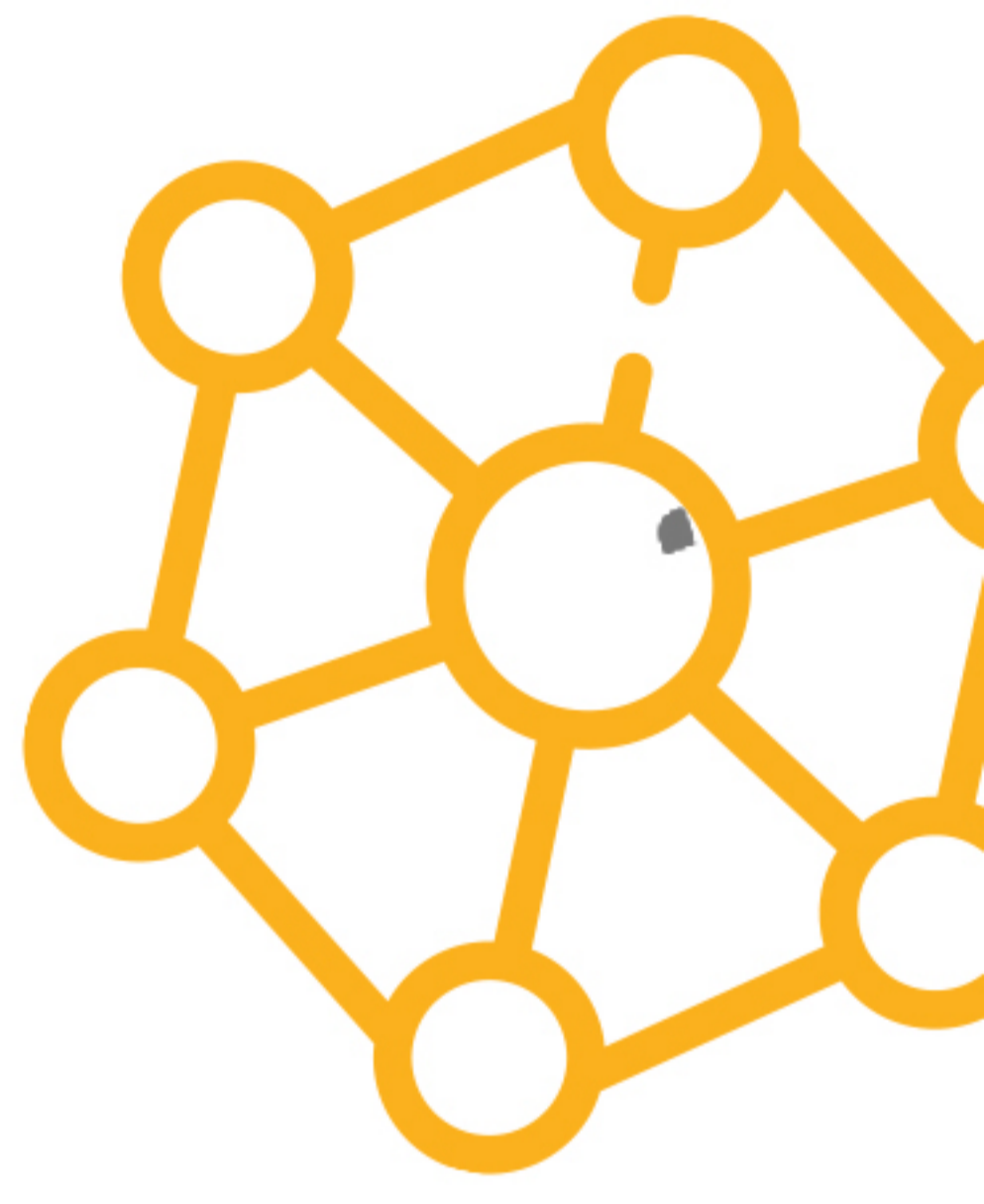

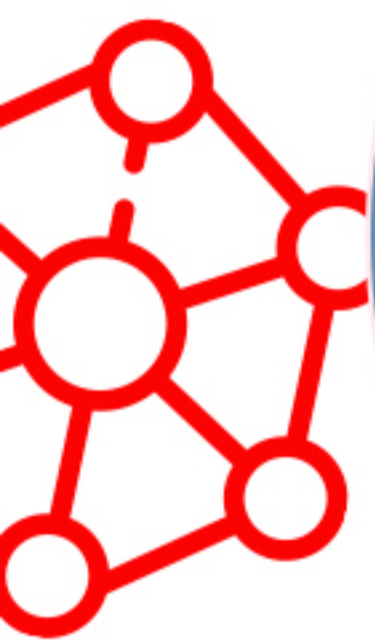

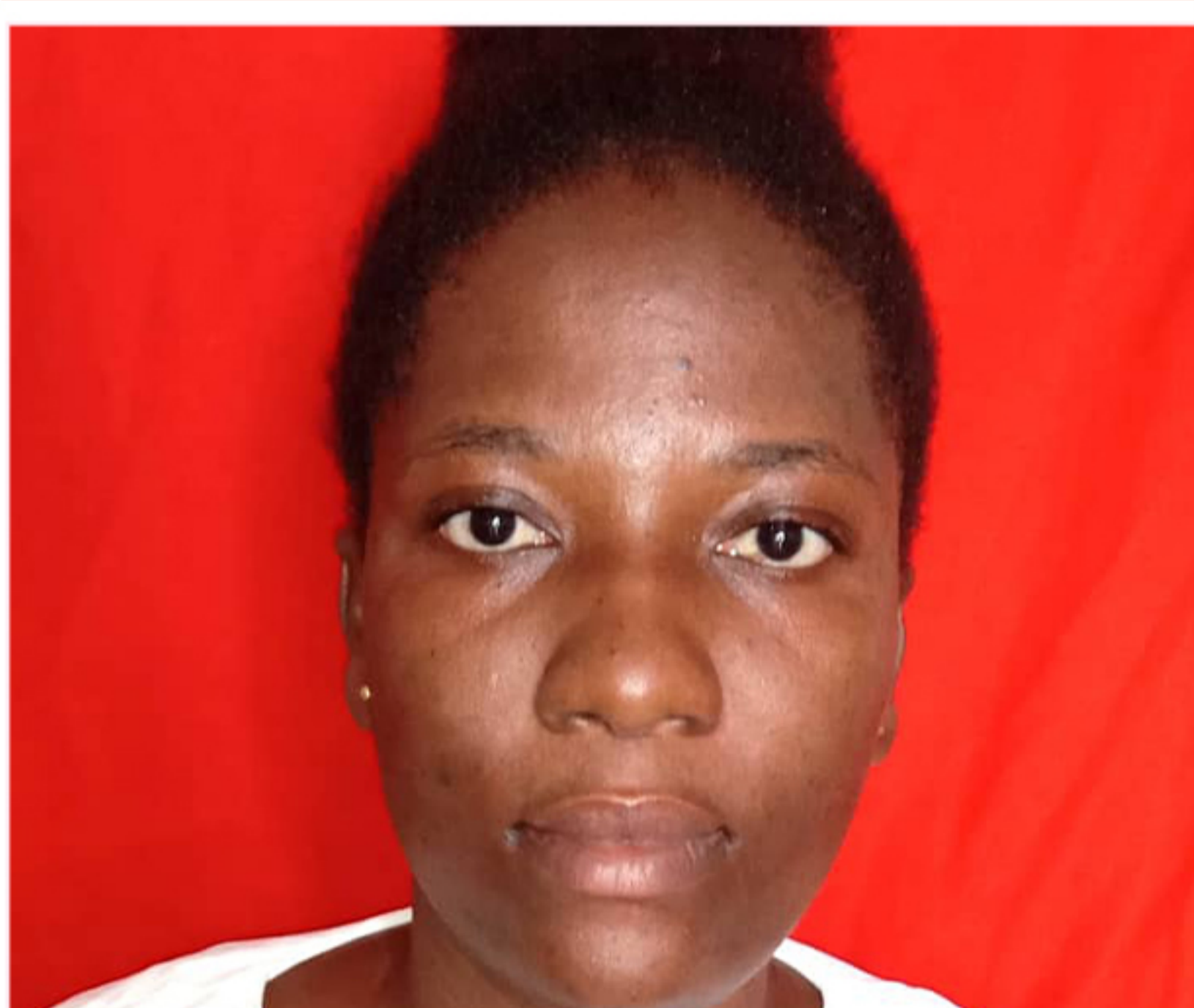

CAREER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM: JHS EDITION

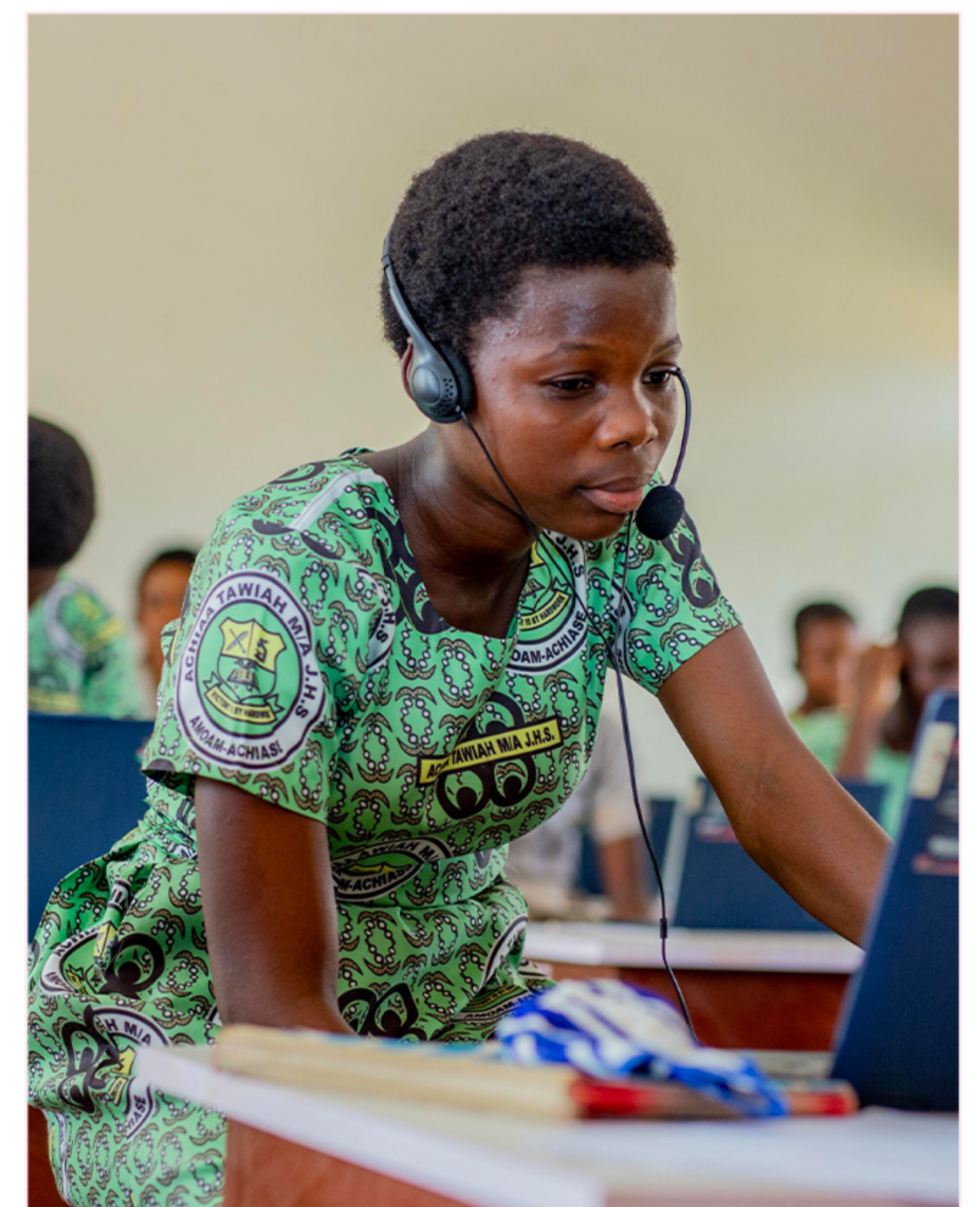
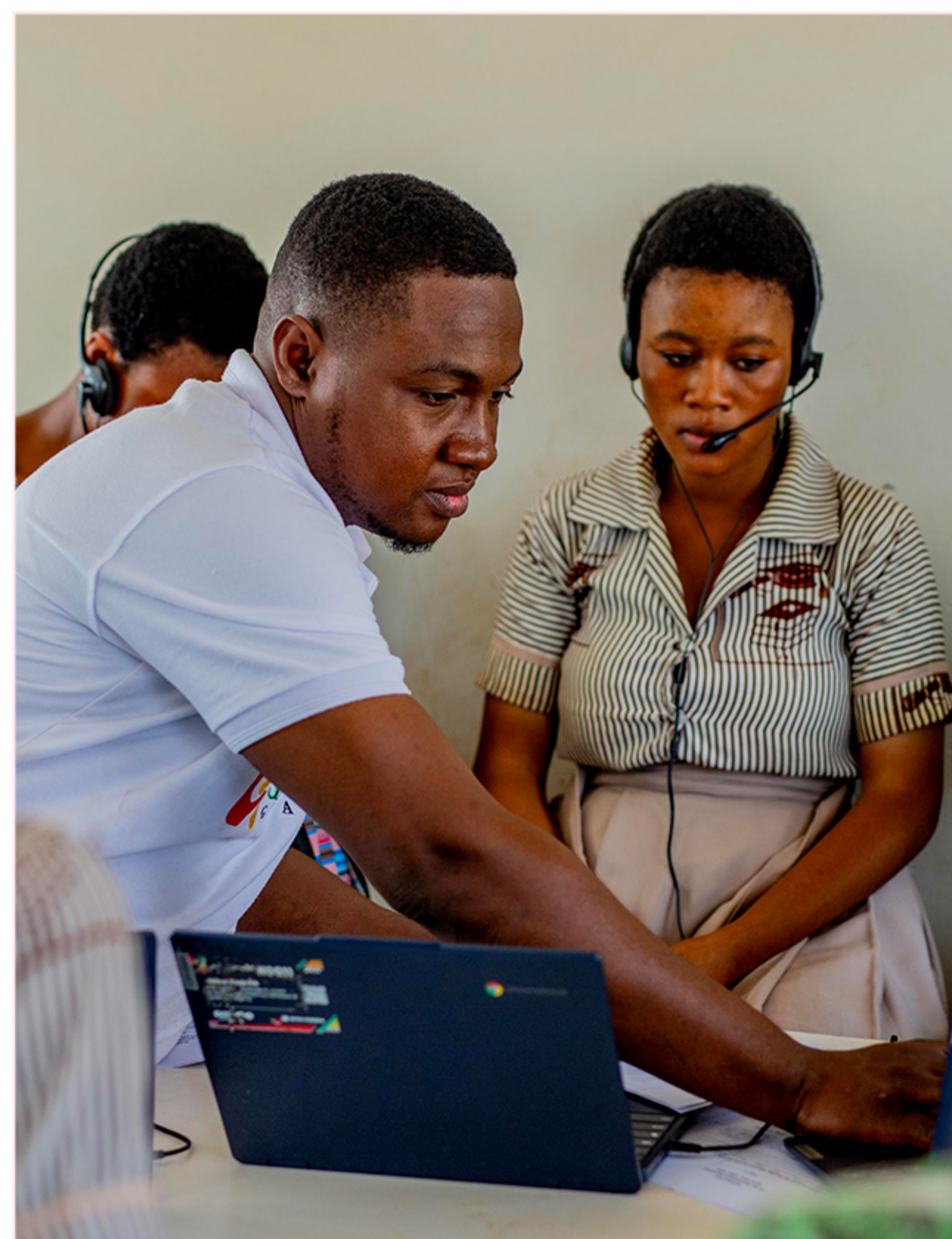

We envision this initiative of Dr Eric growing into a flagship advocacy campaign that not only raises funds but also inspires active participation in education-focused causes.

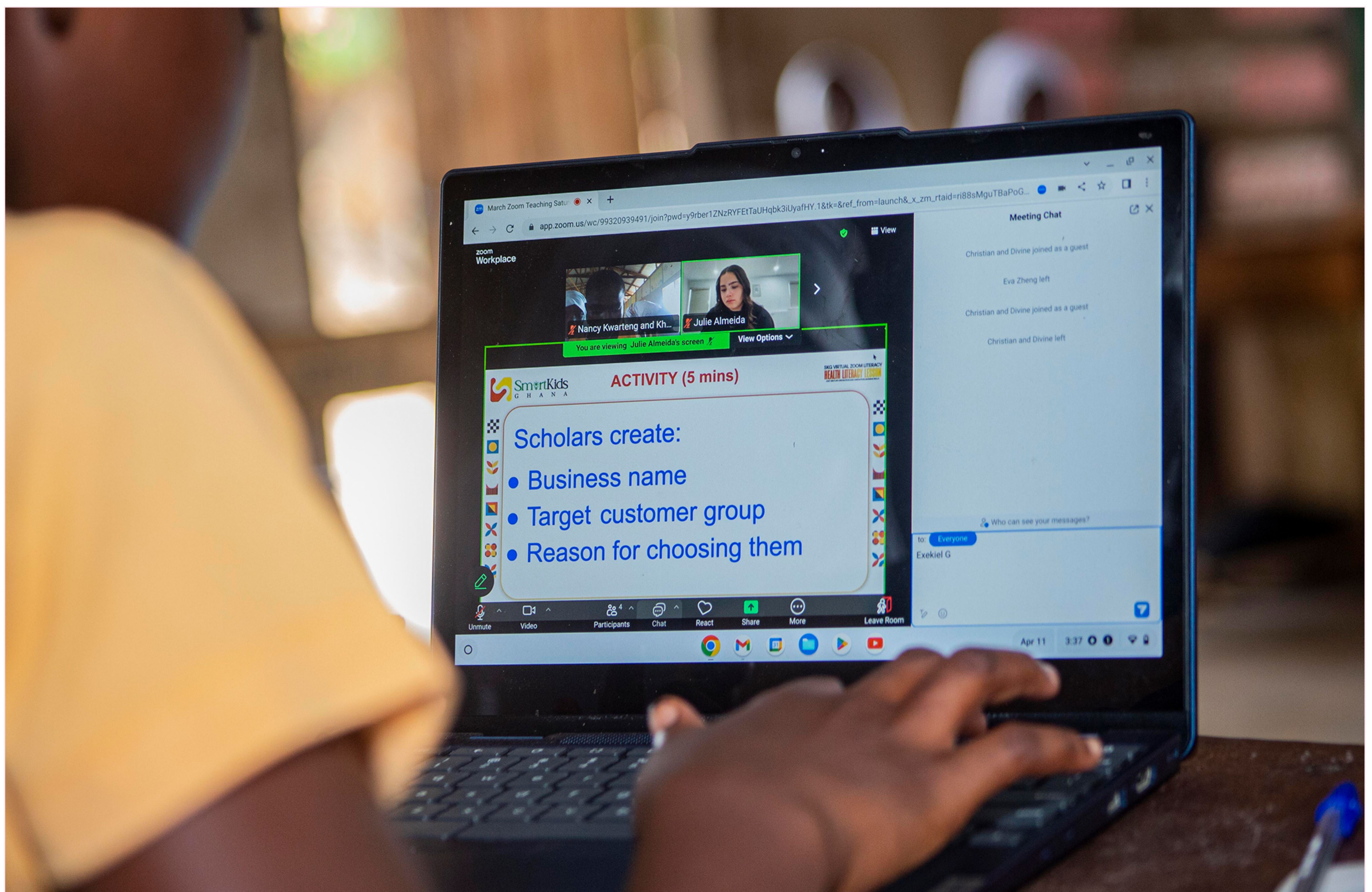


LOOKING AHEAD
