1. Madisen Lovekit – GHS 240.00

This expense covered the purchase and support of educational and program materials associated with the Madisen Lovekit initiative. These materials contributed to student engagement activities and supported the organization's efforts to provide meaningful learning resources for scholars participating in SmartKids Ghana programs.

2. Camera Battery – GHS 200.00

This expenditure covered the purchase of a replacement camera battery used for documenting SmartKids Ghana activities, online teaching sessions, and student engagement programs. Maintaining functional media equipment is important for capturing program impact, creating reports for donors and partners, and supporting organizational communication and outreach.

3. Scholar Certificates – GHS 150.00

This cost covered the printing and preparation of certificates awarded to scholars participating in SmartKids Ghana educational activities. The certificates served as recognition of student participation, commitment, and achievement, while also motivating scholars to remain engaged in their learning journey.
