JUNE FINANCIAL REPORT — GHANA EXPENSES

During the month of June, SmartKids Ghana did not record any Ghana operational expenses in this report. While our team traveled to Wadie Adwumakase to facilitate our Zoom Teaching Program and support students during the virtual lessons, all costs associated with transportation, logistics, and program implementation were fully covered by funds raised specifically through the Zoom Teaching Program fundraising initiative.

As a result, no additional Ghana operational funds were required or expended during the month. This dedicated funding model ensures that the costs of delivering the Zoom Teaching Program are supported directly by the program's fundraising efforts, allowing other organizational resources to be preserved for future educational initiatives.

Throughout June, our focus remained on delivering engaging virtual learning experiences, coordinating volunteers, and supporting students in Wadie Adwumakase. We remain committed to financial transparency and responsible stewardship by ensuring that restricted program funds are used for their intended purpose.

JULY FINANCIAL REPORT — GHANA EXPENSES

This report provides an overview of Ghana-based operational expenditures for the month of July. During July, SmartKids Ghana continued implementing its educational programs while strengthening day-to-day operations, staff support, and program coordination.

The month included continued Teaching Program activities, coordination with scholars, student ambassadors, volunteers, and partners, as well as administrative and logistical activities necessary to ensure the smooth implementation of ongoing programs. July expenses also supported staff communication, transportation, and the maintenance of essential equipment.

Expense Description

1

Monthly Trip — GHS 500.00

This expenditure covered transportation costs associated with SmartKids Ghana's monthly planning, coordination, and operational activities. The trip supported in-person meetings and other essential organizational activities required to coordinate programs, staff, volunteers, and partners effectively.

Executive Assistant Trip Cost — GHS 120.00

This expense covered transportation costs for the Executive Assistant in carrying out organizational responsibilities. The trip supported administrative coordination and other duties necessary for the smooth implementation of SmartKids Ghana's programs and daily operations.

Data Bundle for Staff (5) — GHS 2,000.00

This expenditure covered internet data packages for five SmartKids Ghana staff members. Reliable internet access was essential for coordinating the Teaching Program, communicating with scholars, teachers, student ambassadors, volunteers, and partners, attending virtual meetings, managing schedules, and completing administrative responsibilities. The data support also enabled staff to maintain consistent communication and coordination throughout the month, particularly for activities requiring remote collaboration.

Phone Repairs — GHS 600.00

This expenditure covered repairs to organizational communication equipment. Maintaining functional phones is important for staff communication, coordination with scholars and families, engagement with partners and volunteers, and the day-to-day management of SmartKids Ghana's programs and operations.

Microphone Purchase — GHS 250.00

This expenditure covered the purchase of a microphone to support SmartKids Ghana's educational programs, content shooting, meetings, and other communication and engagement activities. The microphone will help improve audio quality during teaching sessions and organizational events, supporting clearer communication with our videos on social media.

All July expenses are classified as operational costs in SmartKids Ghana's July financial report. Together, these expenses supported the continued implementation of SmartKids Ghana's educational initiatives and strengthened the operational systems necessary to deliver meaningful and sustainable impact.
